

What do the strange icons on the back of the iPhone mean?

If you hold an iPhone 6 or older phone, you will see some strange icons behind the phone.

On newer phones, these icons are transferred to the box and not to the phone. They are not random or meaningful. Each icon has its own message. Let Quantrimang learn the meaning of these symbols.

FCC

In the United States, Federal Communications Commissions is a facility that manages user devices that use radio waves. You will see the FCC logo on products manufactured or sold in the US.

CE

Basically CE means that this device complies with EU EU safety standards. The number 0682 next represents the type of device and the law it applies.

Trash icon is crossed out

The meaning of this icon is obvious, never throw your iPhone into the trash despite how useless it is. The best way if you want to throw it away is sell, give, give or find a reliable recycling place.

Exclamation mark

An exclamation point means that the iPhone may not work as standard in some European countries. Perhaps there is no need to care.

Phone makers don't print the icons behind the device since 2014. Now, the iPhone 8 has the most 'clean' back. That's why you no longer see them on new iPhones but will find them on the iPhone box.
