Although Mario Kart Tour was originally planned by Nintendo to be officially released at the end of March 2019, in the end, some problems caused the project to be delayed until the middle of the year.

On the other hand, Mario Kart Tour is essentially a game developed from the side story, like Mario Kart Arcade GP. However, this is not something too big, nor does it affect the scale and attractiveness of this game. The fact has shown that the Mario Kart series titles have never been badly rated, and there is no reason to doubt that Mario Kart Tour will be an inadequate or unattractive product.

Nintendo's smartphone game market approach is focused on building exclusive privileges for the platform, rather than trying to force, put previously released games on the device. Play games on a mobile device. This leads to many spin-off games that have control methods and play mechanisms that are only suitable for smartphones and other touch-based devices.

And this description line comes from a tweet posted in January 2018.

Apart from this tweet and announcing the delay in the game's release plan, there is no other information that Nintendo has revealed about Mario Kart Tour.

However, as mentioned, this is a Mario Kart series game that many of us are no stranger to, even 'hard' fans for years. Therefore, it is completely predictable that some features will appear on this game. Basically, this version of Mario Kart on smartphones doesn't have the same powerful play and control mechanisms as many Mario Kart games that were previously released for console games. Maybe it will require players to use controls related to rotation, screen navigation like most racing games built for other smartphones, and also Mario Kart Tour as well. may require the device to be connected to the internet continuously while playing.

One thing is for sure, Mario Kart Tour will own many of Nintendo's most iconic characters, and these characters will make races on many roads that are also designed according to some of the themes they have so the name of Nintendo. Besides, the most likely in-game items are also built on this principle, ie getting ideas from Nintendo's most familiar things.

You may think that games involving characters like Super Mario or Link will be Nintendo's best-selling, most popular franchises. But it turns out the truth is that the new Mario Kart series is the best-selling franchise on some Nintendo gaming consoles.

Since then, along with considering how Nintendo operates Super Mario Run - their first mobile game, it is likely that Mario Kart Tour will not be a free game, or support through. advertisement.

Instead, it can come with a fixed price, paid by time or item. That means you will get some music and some characters right after installing the game, but if you want to own any more music or other items, you will have to pay. Or maybe you will only be limited to playing the number of games in the day, and if you want to play more, you have to pay. Or Nintendo will offer some other payment program. This issue is still unknown, but one thing is quite certain that Mario Kart Tour will not be free.
