They're not simply aesthetically pleasing, the yellow lid signifies that the soft drink inside is Kosher - a Passover or Passover drink.

According to KLBD, one of the world's leading kosher agencies, Kosher in Hebrew means "appropriate, suitable or correct". This word describes the strict diet in Judaism.



Dieting Jews must ensure that they eat only meat, poultry, and milk that comes from diet animals and has been prepared in a way specifically for dieters.

There were a number of dietary rules that were added during the spring break of Passover. During Passover, Jews do not consume fermented foods or beverages derived from wheat, barley, oats, rye, or rye, according to KLBD.

## What is kosher made of?

Some people also limit their intake of many nuts, including corn - and that's where Coca-Cola came in.

Traditional Coca-Cola contains a high-fructose corn syrup (fruit sugar) made from corn. So, Coca-Cola created a special version of 'Passover kosher' with non-corn flavors, such as cane or beet sugar, to allow people to enjoy a Coke. on vacation, according to The New York Times.



In a statement to TODAY Food, Coca-Cola said 'The Coca-Cola Company offers year-round kosher (KYR) and Passover kosher (KFP) products.'. Passover Kosher products can be found in select markets during the Jewish

Passover holiday (e.g. March 27 - April 4, 2021).

The company goes on to share 'Only finished products bearing the logo of one of the designated Rabbinical organizations with whom we work can be guaranteed to be Kosher, as production is monitored through these organizations. through the entire production process from start to finish.'



Some non-Jewish people also like to drink this drink as it is a difference in taste of this drink. When the company uses cane or beet sugar, instead of corn syrup, as a sweetener.

This yellow-cap version of Coca-Cola is only available during Passover, and the holiday ends on April 4 of this year.
