

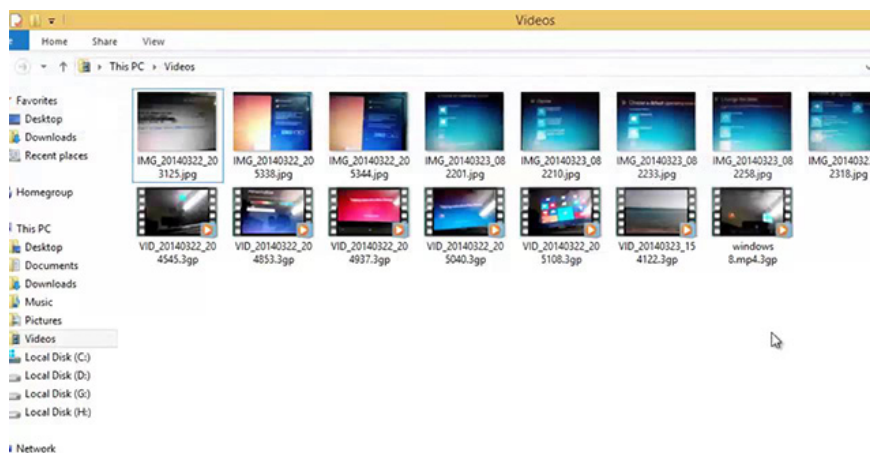
What file is 3GP? How to open, edit and convert 3GP files

3GP format is a video format developed by 3rd Generation Partnership project

3GP format is a video format developed by 3rd Generation Partnership project. 3GPP and 3GPP2 are the standards used for the creation, distribution and playback of multimedia files on high-speed 3G wireless networks. This format is commonly used on phones that support video recording. 3GP is based on MPEG-4 standard - which originates from Apple's QuickTime format.

The 3GP video file format has been developed towards the purpose of saving disk space, bandwidth and data usage, which is why they are often created, used and converted between mobile devices.

3GP is the standard format, the format required for media files is sent by Multimedia Messaging Service (Multimedia Messaging Service- MMS) and Multimedia Broadcast Multicast Services (MBMS).



Note: Sometimes, files in 3GP format can use the .3GPP file extension but in essence they are no different from regular .3GP files.

3GP and 3G2

3G2 is a format very similar to 3GP, they carry many useful features but also have some limitations compared to the 3GP format.

While 3GP is the standard video format for GSM-based phones, CDMA phones use 3G2 format. Both file formats can store the same video stream but the 3GP format is considered superior because it can store ACC + and AMR-WB + audio streams. However, compared to 3G2, it cannot record EVRC, 13K and SMV / VMR audio streams.

In general, in actual use of 3GP or 3G2 files, 3GP open and convert tools can almost always work with 3G2 files similar to 3GP.

How to open a 3GP and 3G2 file

Both 3GP and 3G2 formats can be played easily on a variety of 3G mobile devices without a separate application. Although there may be some limitations, generally, mobile devices, either 2G or 4G, almost always support the playback of 3GP and 3G2 files.

Note: If you want to use a separate mobile application to play 3GP files, the OPlayer is an interesting option for iOS users. While Android users can use MX Player or Simple MP4 Video Player (in addition these applications can also open many other media file formats like MP4, FLV .).

You can also open these multimedia files on your computer with the operating system's default programs. But there are a lot of useful software that supports free 3GP and 3G2 file reading. For example, you can use software like Apple's free QuickTime media player, free VLC media player or MPlayer program. These are all multimedia broadcasting tools used by many people.

As mentioned above, You can also open 3G2 and 3GP files with Microsoft Windows Media Player, preinstalled in Windows. However, you may need to install an additional codec so that they display properly, like the free FFDSHOW MPEG-4 video decoder.

How to convert 3GP and 3G2

If you can't play a 3GP or 3G2 file on your computer or mobile device, convert them to a more popular format like MP4, AVI or MKV. You can refer to one of these free video conversion programs. One of the free video converters can support both the most popular 3GP and 3G2 formats, Any Video Converter.

Zamzar and FileZigZag are two free online file converters, which convert these files right on the web server, which means you don't need to waste time downloading and installing any software. Just download the 3GP or 3G2 file to convert to one of those sites and install the conversion option to any format, be it 3GP-to-3G2 or 3G2-to-3GP, as well as convert to MP3 , FLV, WEBM, WAV, FLAC, MPG, WMV, MOV or any other popular audio or video formats.

FileZigZag also allows you to select the device you want to convert 3GP or 3G2 files to. This is really useful if you are not sure about the formats that your device can support or which file format is required to play on each specific device. You can choose from custom settings like Android, Xbox, PS3, BlackBerry, iPad, iPhone and other devices.

Note: Many people usually just change the file format by right-clicking on the file's name, in fact renaming without actually converting the file. Often these files after renaming still cannot be opened on your device. In most cases, converting the actual file format with one of the methods described above is mandatory (a file

converter can convert many different file types such as documents and images. image).

However, because they all use the same codec, you can completely rename the 3GP or 3G2 file to a .MP4 file. The same is true for .3GPP files.
