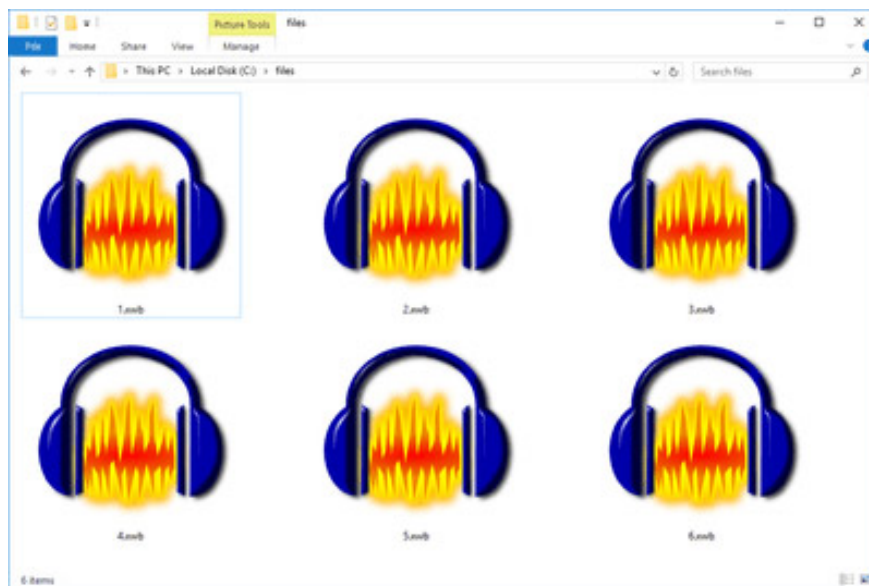


# What file is CDDA? How to open, edit and convert CDDA files

A file with the .CDDA extension is a CD Digital Audio file, which stores audio in AIFF format

A file with the .CDDA extension is a CD Digital Audio file, which stores audio in AIFF format. CDDA file format is usually only seen when audio files are extracted from audio CDs using standard CD Digital Audio. This is usually done through the Apple iTunes program with the CD burning option available.

## How to open a CDDA file

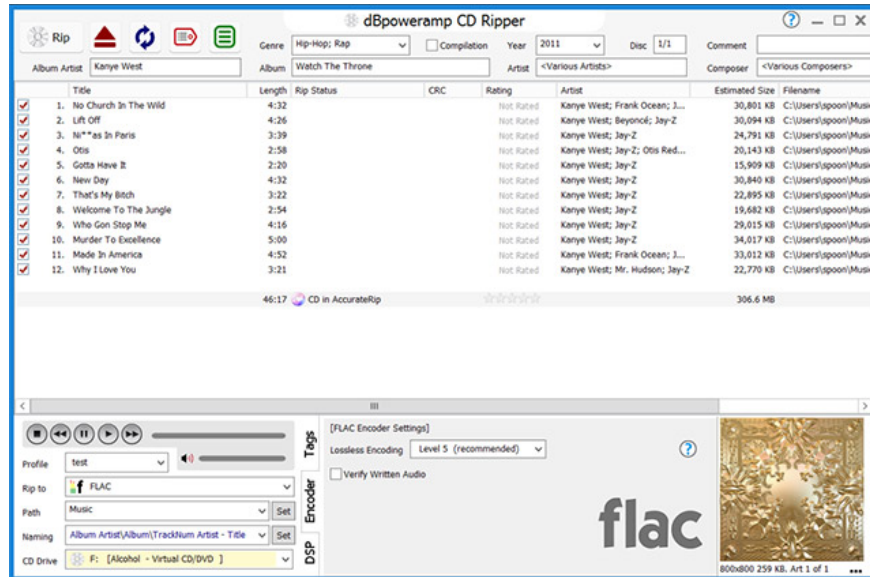


CDDA files can be opened for free with Apple's iTunes and several other free multimedia players on Windows and macOS.

Note: You can also burn audio files to CDDA format using **File > Burn Playlist to Disc option** in iTunes. Just be sure to choose the right playlist you want to record.

If you find that an application on your PC tried to open the CDDA file but it is an application that you do not want to use or if you want another program to open CDDA files, see the article '7 ways to change Default applications in Windows' to understand how to do that.

# How to convert a CDDA file



The CD Ripper software of dBpoweramp is not a free program but has a trial version that you can download for Windows and Mac to convert your CDDA files to WAV and other audio formats. Quick way.

If after converting the CDDA file with CD Ripper, you want to convert this file to another format but not supported by CD Ripper, try using one of the free audio format conversion programs in the list ' Our top 10 audio and audio converter software currently saves CDDA files to MP3, WAV format or any other popular audio format. In addition, you can also convert other audio formats to CDDA using the software listed above. However, keep in mind that some of the popular audio formats such as MP3 and AAC are lossy audio (lossy) audio formats, meaning that some audio data is clipped to reduce size. file. Therefore, when you convert from MP3 format to CDDA, you will not be able to restore previously cut audio data on MP3 files even under CDDA format, simply by that data section. has been permanently deleted.

Note: Typically, you will not be able to change the file extension (such as the .CDDA file extension) extension that your computer recognizes (like .MP3) just by renaming the file and hoping. Newly renamed files can be used. The actual file format conversion must be done with one of the file converters as mentioned above.

## How can I still open a CDDA file?



If you still cannot open CDDA files even though you have used the above methods, it is possible that your file is not really in CDDA format. Some types of file extensions have a look that looks very similar to the extension of the .CDDA file, so you should also check the file extension to see if it is standard. CDA files are an example of a situation that can cause confusion. CDA files are Shortcut CD Audio Track files and have nothing to do with CDDA. Although they can still be used with iTunes and other audio players, they are actually just a reference file to playlists on CDs. Therefore, you will not be able to use them as a regular audio file.

Another file may be mistaken for CDDA as CCD. These are CloneCD disk image files created by CloneCD and used by programs like ImgBurn. They have absolutely nothing to do with CDDA files and therefore cannot be opened in regular multimedia players.
