

What if Widgets appear right in the Start Menu of Windows 11

Windows 11 will be officially released on October 5, so it is very unlikely that it will have unexpected changes. Start Menu, Widget... almost no design adjustment.

Up to this point, Windows 11's new Start Menu has received mixed reviews, with likes and dislikes. This new design has many improvements but also has many limitations and difficulties in customization. Meanwhile, Widget is just a phase of renaming, relocating from News and Interests of Windows 10, not much different.

To show everyone a more compelling example of Windows 11, designer Gab Leo tried integrating Widgets into the new Start Menu. You can observe this idea through the photo below:



This idea has a few appeals compared to the current Windows 11 design. First, it's a natural departure from the Windows 10 Start Menu, which consists of application icons and provisioning tiles. information in the form of live tiles.

Second, this interface is quite familiar to Android users, the largest number of smartphone users in the world today. And in fact, now even iOS with versions 14 and 15 are using a widget-style design interwoven with app icons.

However, it is a pity that this is just an idea and concept created by the designer. There is almost no chance of Microsoft taking this idea and bringing it to Windows 11 in the near future.
