From an energy and cost saving perspective, automatic blinds work well with smart light bulbs, as the lightness of the light bulb can be adjusted based on the sunlight shining into the room.

1. **Easy access** : No need to stand up or go to the window to adjust the curtain anymore, you can do it while lying down on the couch or simply by a voice command from the virtual assistant.
