3. Vector graphics in Illustrator

One of the most outstanding advantages of Adobe Illustrator is that the quality of the artwork created is independent of the resolution at which it is displayed; that is, images created in Illustrator can be enlarged or reduced without any loss of quality. This is a property of vector graphics, which uses mathematical relationships in describing the lines and other parts of the illustration.

Images edited using tools like Adobe Photoshop are resolution-dependent, resulting in reduced image quality when enlarged. Vector graphics are a collection of polygons that make up an image, which in turn consist of vectors.

Each vector passes through a point called a node or control point, which has a defined position on the x and y axes of the plane. This node defines the vector path, including various attributes such as color, curve, shape, and thickness. The positions of vectors can be related to each other using mathematical formulas, precisely recalculating their positions when an image is resized.

This property of vector graphics is different when compared to image editing software like Photoshop, which uses a pixel grid to render images. When this type of image is scaled down, the individual pixels that make up the bitmap become visible, resulting in a reduction in image quality.
