From haunted object to pop culture icon

Annabelle became world famous after appearing in The Conjuring film universe . In the film, she is portrayed as a creepy porcelain doll, much more terrifying than the real doll — a change made by the filmmakers to add to the scare factor.

However, the real version of Raggedy Ann still retains its creepy reputation, especially among fans of the supernatural. Whether people believe the story or not, the doll has become a combination of folklore, horror movie icon, and internet obsession.

This week's scare seems to have started when news of the resort fire hit social media around the same time the Annabelle doll was said to be on tour. It didn't take long for people to connect the dots—or jump to conclusions. Theories about the doll escaping or causing chaos have popped up on TikTok and X, with reactions ranging from pranks to actual prayers to even a mock exorcism.

Where is Annabelle doll?

Despite all the speculation, the doll is still right where it belongs. Dan Rivera of the New England Society for Psychical Research (NESPR) posted a video from inside the Warren Occult Museum, showing Annabelle safe inside a glass case.

Even though the story has been debunked, it's clear that the legend of Annabelle is still very much alive — and it doesn't look like that fear is going away anytime soon.
