What is clipboard?

This is a temporary storage area of ??memory, which contains data that is cut or copied from a document or software until you "paste" this data somewhere.

The meaning of the Clipboard in Windows

Clipboard in Windows is a part of RAM, also known as temporary cache used by the system to write user data. Those data are usually text, images, files. Users can write data of software A to this special memory, ie Clipboard, by pressing Ctrl + C, and also paste data from that memory into software B by pressing Ctrl + V.



For example: When you edit Word, you will sometimes need to copy or move a paragraph using Ctrl + C or Ctrl + X, this time the text is saved to the Clipboard, then you press Ctrl + V to paste the text in the position you want.

Or in System, you want to copy images from this folder to another folder, when you press Ctrl + C or Ctrl + X to copy or cut the image, the image will be saved to the Clipboard, then the select the folder you want to copy, move the image in and press Ctrl + V to paste the image from the Clipboard to that folder.

What can you copy to the Clipboard?

You can copy anything that can be selected in Windows: text of all types, graphics, files (including keyboard shortcuts) or folders.

What can you paste from the Clipboard?

Paste the contents of the Clipboard depending on where you want to make the paste. For example, if you are working with text, you can only paste text in applications and programs that work with text. Following the same rule, you can only paste graphics in applications and programs that work with graphics, etc.

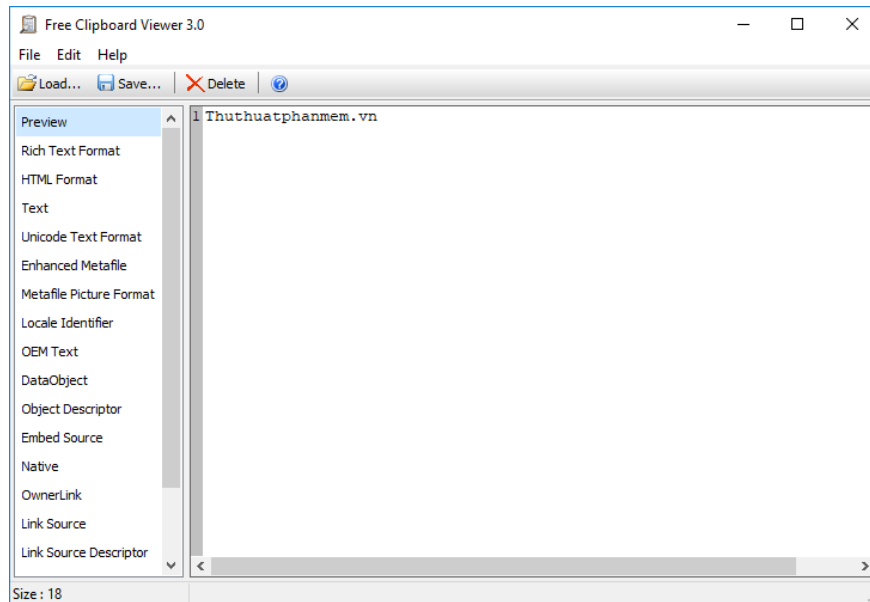
If the Clipboard content cannot be pasted where you want it, it will not be pasted, but the Clipboard content will remain intact.

Note: all clipboard data will be deleted when the computer is turned off.

How to manage Clipboard in Windows?

Windows XP has Clipboard Viewer which allows users to view the contents of the clipboard locally, delete the clipboard or save the copied and cut items. But with the version of Windows Vista and subsequent versions of Windows 7, 8, 8.1, 10, it was deleted. To view and manage the clipboard, you can use the Clipboard Viewer program.
