

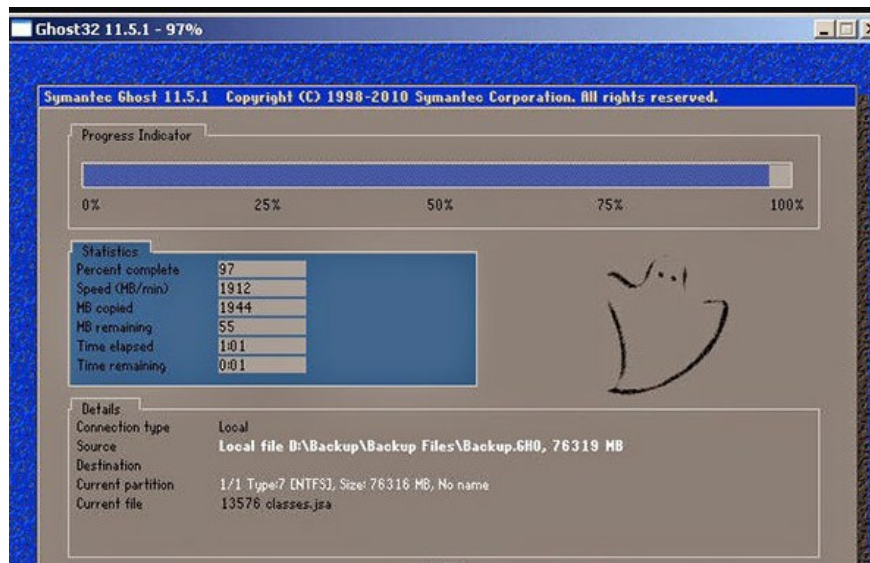
What is Ghost Win? How does it work?

What is the difference between Ghost Win and installing Windows?

As mentioned above, a complete ghost win will clone all settings, software or data saved on the hard drive. Therefore, ghost win will help you quickly return the computer to a complete installation state, ready to use as quickly as possible.

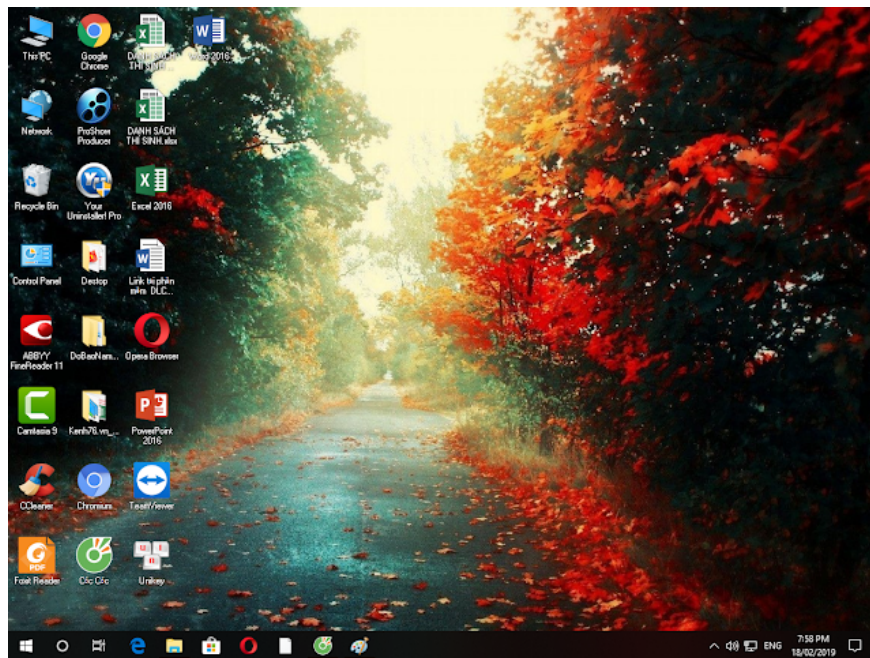
Instead, if we install Windows in the usual way, we only reset the data about the operating system and default software. For example, with normal working computers and laptops, we will have to start downloading and reinstalling software such as Unikey, Winrar, Microsoft Office,.

Pros and Cons of Using Ghost

Advantages of ghosting Windows

Ghost win brings speed and convenience every time you need to reinstall your computer. Normally, extracting a ghost file is quite fast, it only takes about 15-20 minutes for a complete ghost version instead of having to reinstall for hours compared to installing win.

Ghost versions, if integrated with all-in-one driver or full software, when released, you will not need to install anything else but can start working and use immediately.



Disadvantages of ghost

Most of the ghost versions shared online have been edited, added and removed a lot of data, personalized according to the author's preferences.

There is a risk of minor errors. The author added or removed a few elements on the ghost version that may be compatible with their device. But when used on your configuration, if it is not compatible, it will cause the device to slow down, have problems, and operate sluggishly.

Easily infected with viruses and spyware if you download ghost versions from unreliable sources.
