What is GPA? What is a GPA?

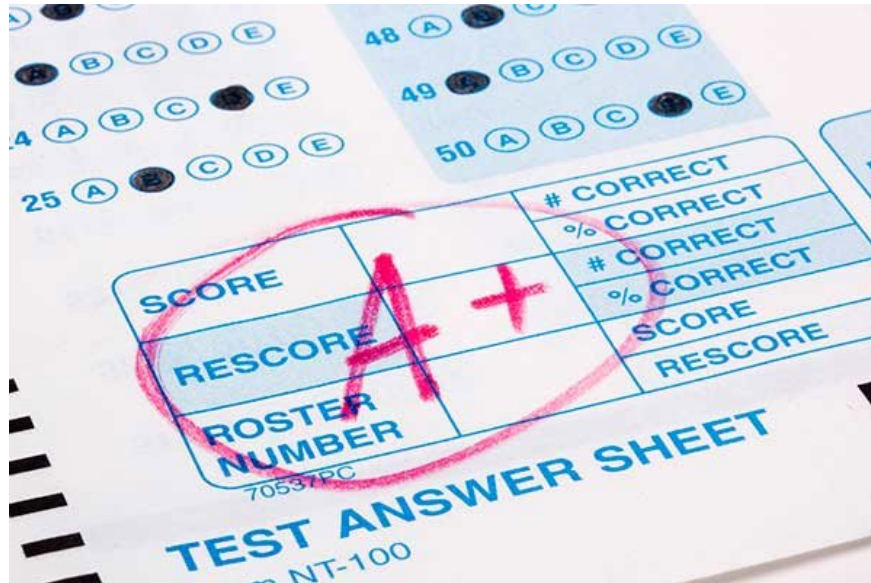
GPA is an acronym for Grade Point Average, which means **the average score of a student** in the US education system. This score will partly assess the student's ability to learn, thereby indicating the level of the student to where.

The way to calculate the GPA is to add the average of the subjects and divide the result to get the average score. The detailed formula of GPA is:

$$GPA = \frac{\sum \text{điểm trung bình môn} * \text{số tín chỉ/môn}}{\text{tổng số tín chỉ}}$$

When the results are available, the GPA scale is calculated on a scale of A, B, C, D or 0-4 but not the 10 point scale as in Vietnam.

For students who want to apply for universities in the US, the GPA must be a minimum of 3.3, to get a scholarship, the GPA must be over 3.9.



In addition to GPA scores, US schools also consider extra-curricular activities that students take to associate with the grades you have earned. If you participate in many extracurricular activities will be greatly appreciated. In addition, some universities in the US also take some additional tests such as SAT, TOEFL, IELTS, GMAT, GRE, recommendation letters, essays and experiences of students .
