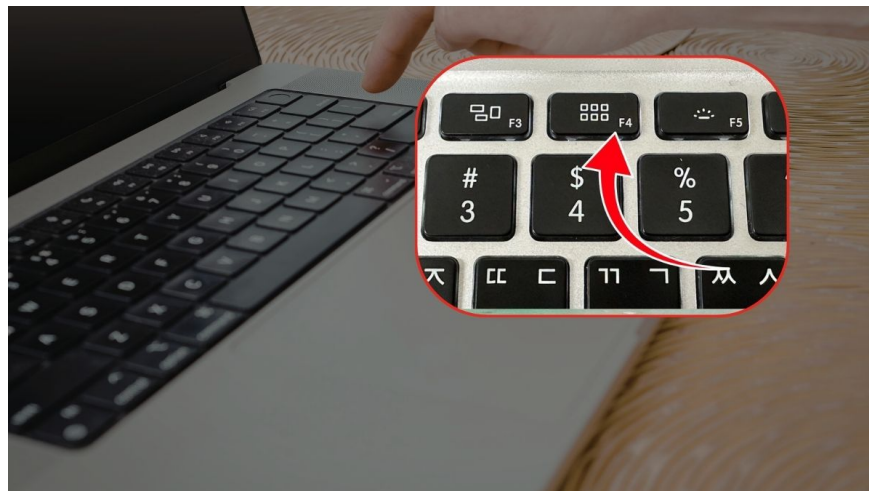

Open Launchpad using the keyboard.

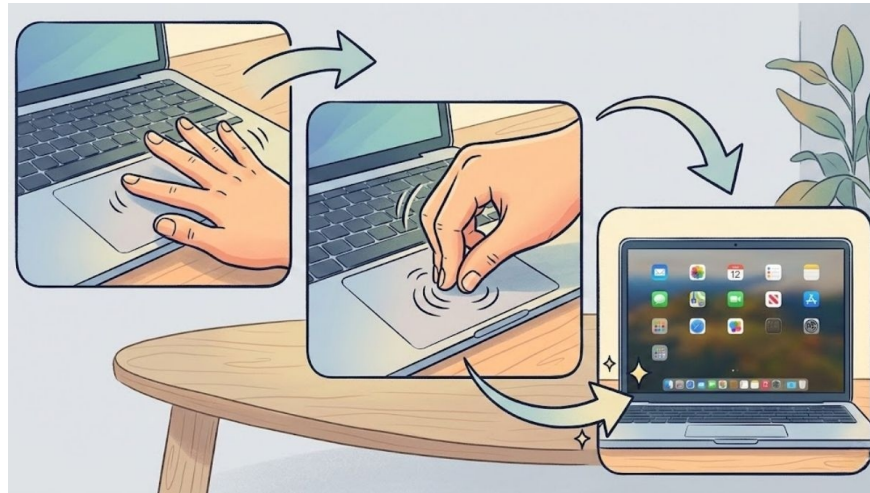
A quick and common way to open Launchpad on a MacBook is to press the F4 key (usually marked with a grid icon). If your keyboard is in special function mode (such as volume control), you need to press Fn + F4 to activate it.



You can customize this shortcut through the Keyboard section in System Settings to better suit your needs. This allows for quick access without taking your hands off the keyboard, ideal for everyday work.

Open Launchpad using Trackpad

To open Launchpad via the trackpad on a MacBook, you pinch your thumb and three fingers together on the surface. This gesture works smoothly on MacBook models that support Multi-Touch, allowing quick access without removing your hand from the trackpad.



If the gesture isn't responding, check and enable the option in the Trackpad section of System Settings to ensure it's activated. This method of opening Launchpad on a MacBook is especially convenient when multitasking, allowing you to quickly switch between application grids without using an external mouse.

Open Launchpad from the Dock

To open Launchpad from the Dock on your MacBook, simply find the application grid icon in the Dock at the bottom of the screen and left-click it. If the Dock is hidden, move your mouse cursor to the bottom edge of the screen to make it visible, then click the icon.

1. **Step 2:** Press and hold the left mouse button on any application icon until the icons start to shake slightly and an X appears in the corner.
2. **Step 3:** Drag one app icon and drop it on top of another.
3. **Step 4:** Name the folder

Note that Apple removed the icon rearrangement and folder creation features from Launchpad in macOS 26 Tahoe.

How to remove apps from Launchpad on a Macbook

Launchpad allows you to quickly remove unused app icons, resulting in a cleaner display.

1. **Step 1:** Click the Launchpad icon on the Dock.
1. **Step 2:** Press and hold the left mouse button on any app icon until all the icons start shaking slightly and an X appears in the upper corner.
2. **Step 3:** Tap directly on the X icon of the app you want to remove.
3. **Step 4:** **Tap the Delete** button on the notification to confirm and remove it.

Note: Pressing the X and confirming Delete will uninstall the application from your Mac. If you only want to clean up the interface for a cleaner look, group infrequently used applications into folders.

How to reset Launchpad to default settings on a Macbook.

While using Launchpad, you can restore the original layout structure by using a simple command via Terminal to delete custom data.

1. **Step 1:** Open the Terminal.
1. **Step 2:** Type the following command into Terminal: **defaults write com.apple.dock ResetLaunchPad -bool true; killall Dock** , then press Enter.
1. **Step 3:** Return to Launchpad to test.

Notes on using Launchpad on a Macbook

Here are some practical tips to help you use Launchpad more effectively on macOS and avoid unnecessary problems.

1. **Always prioritize using the search box as soon as you open Launchpad:** Just type a few letters and the application will appear instantly, faster than manually browsing through pages.
2. **Organize applications into folders based on their function** (e.g., Productivity, Creative, Utilities) to reduce the number of pages displayed and improve overall visibility.
3. **Set a Hot Corner (screen corner)** to activate Launchpad by hovering your mouse over the bottom-left corner – convenient for using your mouse or trackpad without pressing a shortcut key.
4. **Avoid dragging and dropping applications too much if your computer is running many heavy tasks** , as this can cause temporary slowdowns; restart the Dock via Terminal if the interface is lagging.
5. **Check the Applications folder if the newly installed app doesn't appear** - Launchpad only displays apps that are in the correct location in the system.
6. With the new operating system update from Apple, Launchpad may change its interface, name, or be replaced with a new management interface.

Launchpad on a Macbook becomes powerful when you combine quick search with organized, personalized settings. Using the app with these helpful tips will make your workflow faster, smoother, and significantly save you time in your daily tasks.
