

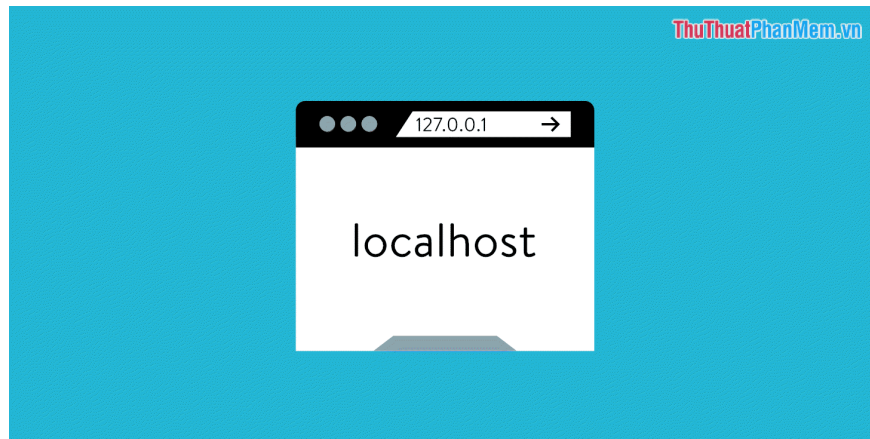
What is localhost?

Localhost will directly use the resources on your computer (hard drive) to store data. But you can not share that Web site for others to see but only your computer can view it (Because Localhost is on your computer and uses the resources of your computer).
