Handling pay-outs is arguably the most important role that a casino dealer has. You must handle player bets correctly and of course precision is key, as are maths skills, as you want to get things right quickly and the first time - constantly making mistakes is not a good look.

Having a knowledge of the game rules

You can't run a casino game without in-depth knowledge of the rules. Casinos will teach you the rules before you're sent out onto a table, but there are resources you can use online to add to your knowledge, such as reading guides or watching videos on YouTube. An in-depth understanding of the game allows you to handle fringe situations easily. This improves the player experience, as there's less confusion and less waiting around for the floor to handle the situation.
