

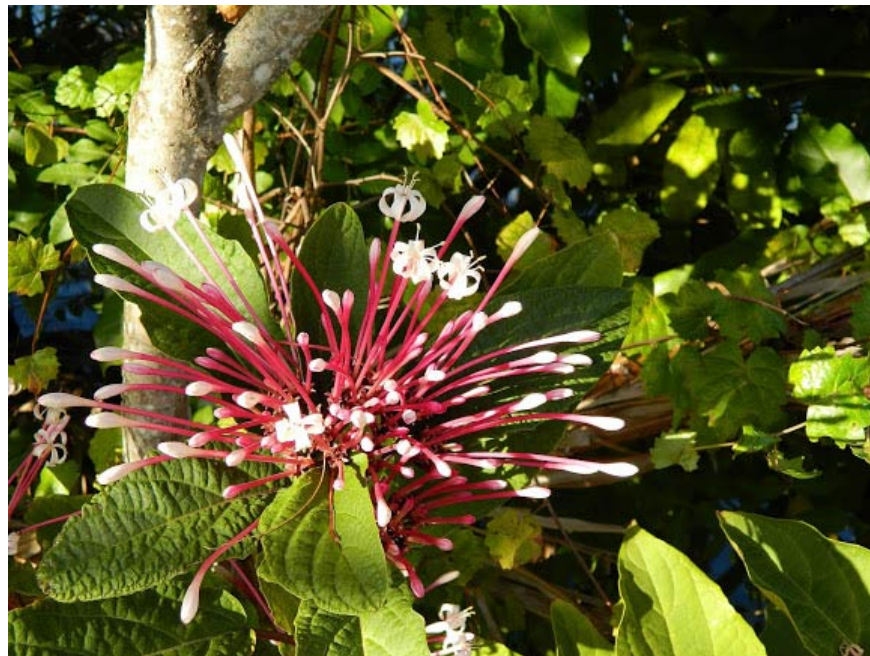
What is starburst bush?

What does starburst bush mean?

Starburst bush is one of the names of the flower Clerodendrum quadriloculare, native to the island nation of Papua New Guinea and the Philippines, and is a flowering plant in the Peppermint family, the Basil family. This plant was described by a scientist and in 1905.

Clerodendrum quadriloculare is **the scientific name of a species of Vietnamese name is fireworks** , or fireworks, American ornamental, woody, with flowers blooming in clusters similar to the shape of fireworks and fireworks. Flowers will gather in clusters at the top of each scene, each inflorescence is made from small flowers and blooms like fireworks are exploding. Perennial plants can grow up to 3m, young green stems, old woody but easy to break. Leaves are large, greenish purple, dark green upper surface below purple.



This flower likes light, it needs a lot of sunlight to flower, it should take a lot of water for the tree but at an appropriate level, because the tree cannot stand waterlogging. Plants often flower all year round but concentrate most on Tet. In fact, this flower was introduced to Vietnam more than 2 years ago by many families playing flowers whenever Tet comes because the flowers bloom are very beautiful. In addition, **ha also means feng shui** , **bringing a lot of luck for the new year** like the name of a flower when blooming into clusters of fireworks.
