

# What is Tactile? Distinguishing Tactile from other types of switches

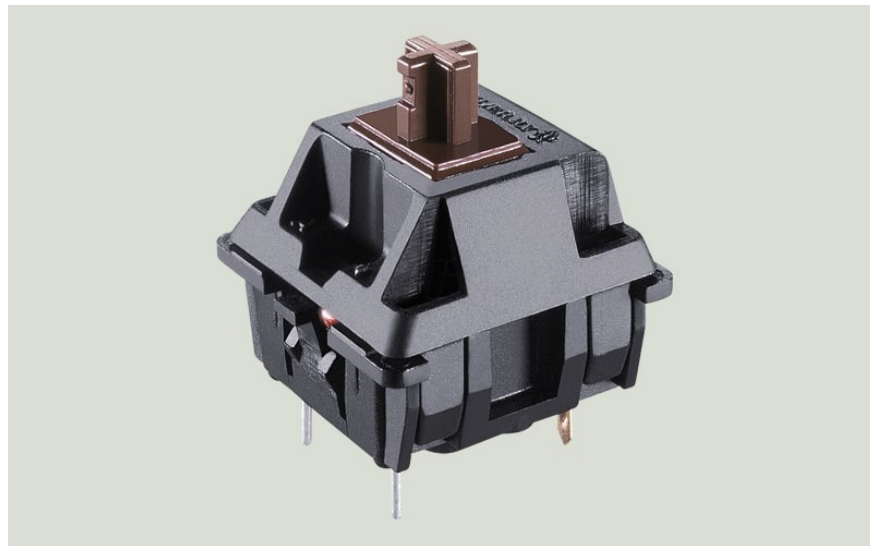
Understanding what Tactile is, knowing the advantages and disadvantages of this Switch design style will help you choose the mechanical keyboard that best suits you.

### *Some popular Switch types today*

Currently, in addition to *Tactile switches* , Linear and Clicky are also popular mechanical keyboard switch designs. *Tactile vs Linear* will bring a lighter typing feeling, especially Linear Switch, the type of switch that gives the smoothest and most comfortable pressing feeling. If you often have to type text and do not like noise, this is the perfect choice.



On the contrary, Clicky Switch is the type of switch with the loudest keystroke sound with clear clicks throughout the entire operation process. This type of Switch is quite noisy with 'click click' sounds but in return, the response speed is very fast and highly accurate, so it is very popular with gamers and is the first choice of millions of gamers around the world.

## What are the advantages and disadvantages of Tactile Switch?

### Advantages of Tactile

1. High precision, fast response for a comfortable typing feel
2. Has a more pronounced tactile feel than Linear
3. Moderate noise is acceptable not too loud like Clicky
4. Long life, most of the popular *Tactile Switches* on the market today have a life span of more than 50 million clicks.
5. Diverse choices from many brands with many different price segments.
6. The internal structure is more resistant to dust and water than other Switch lines.
7. ***Tactile Keyboard*** has good response, high precision, tactile feel and low noise, so it is chosen by many people for working, typing or playing their favorite games.

### Disadvantages of Tactile

1. **Tactile** does not give the same quiet feeling as Linear, especially silent Switch types.
2. There is a bump when pressing so it takes time to get used to the keys for first time users.
3. The tactile and responsiveness of *Tactile Linear* has not reached the speed of Clicky.

# How to distinguish Tactile, Clicky and Linear Switch

To distinguish between *Tactile Linear* and Clicky, you can try typing directly. Each person will have different feelings. Depending on your preferences, you can choose a mechanical keyboard with the right switch.



Distinguish **Tactile** from Clicky and Linear Switch based on the following criteria:

| Key travel difference | Has a gentle, moderate notch              | No notch                                | Clear notch                             |
