

What is the true value of the prestigious Oscar gold statue?

The Oscar is the most prestigious and prestigious film award in the world, recognizing outstanding achievements of the year by actors, directors, scripts and many other areas.

The Oscar statue is made by the hands of artisans at the Pillich Tallix art workshop, USA. The statue is a picture of a knight holding a sword, standing on a roll of film stretching out like 5 petals symbolizing directors, actors, producers, screenwriters and technicians, the 5 most important factors that make up the success of a cinematographic work.

Each Oscar statue is about 24cm tall, weighs 3.86kg, is plated in 24 karat gold and has a unique serial number touching the front and back of the film.



Although only gold plated, but the cost to produce an Oscar statue is not cheap, about 500 USD.

Materials for making this statue include nickel, copper, silver and 24 karat gold. To complete an Oscar statue it takes 12 people to work meticulously within 20 hours.
