

What is visa-free?

Visa-free or visa-free is a very familiar term for those who often travel abroad. So what is visa exemption and which country has Vietnam exempted visa for?

If you often have to move to foreign countries to work, you must have heard the term visa, visa exemption or these terms also appear on television, newspapers, radio, etc. A visa is considered to be a legal, verified evidence that allows someone to enter or leave the country of visa. So what does visa exemption mean and how many countries do visa-free countries with Vietnam and Vietnam currently exempt from?

How is visa exemption?

Currently to facilitate some cases of entry into Vietnam we have exempted visas. **Visa waiver means that the country allows a number of special subjects to enter and exit priority, regardless of the purpose of entry and exit**. Citizens of other countries who are exempted from visa will be stored for a period of time without the need to do the procedures as well as pay the fees related to the entry and exit.

Vietnam will exempt visas for Vietnamese citizens residing abroad, foreigners are spouses, children of Vietnamese citizens, or some other subjects under the unilateral and bilateral visa exemption regulations of Vietnam.

Vietnam visa exemption for any country?

Citizens of some countries below are exempted from the ordinary visa when entering Vietnam:

1. Brunei: Duration of temporary residence in Vietnam does not exceed 14 days.
2. Japan, Korea, Sweden, Norway, Denmark, Russia, Finland, Germany, France, Great Britain, Italy and Spain: The duration of stay is no longer than 15 days.
3. Philippines: Temporary stay not exceeding 21 days.
4. Thailand, Malaysia, Singapore, Indonesia, Cambodia, Laos: The duration of temporary stay does not exceed 30 days.
5. Chile is allowed to stay for not more than 90 days
6. Citizens of France and Chile with diplomatic passports or official passports are exempt from visa for a single stay or a multiple stay for a total period not exceeding 90 days within 6 months from the date of entry. first sight.
7. Holders of business travel cards from countries that are members of the Asia-Pacific Economic Cooperation Forum (APEC) are exempt from Vietnam visa for a stay not exceeding 60 days.
8. Foreigners or Vietnamese nationals traveling to Phu Quoc Island will be exempt from Vietnam visa for a stay of 15 days. If you want to visit other areas, you must apply for a Vietnam visa.



Which countries exempt visa visas for Vietnam?

There are 48 countries that exempt visas for Vietnam. Vietnamese citizens only need a valid passport.

Country Name Content Thailand, Dominica, Micronesia, Cambodia, Malaysia, Palau, Samoa, Somalia, Tuvalu, Maldives, India, Burundi Duration of stay not exceeding 30 days Singapore Duration of stay not exceeding 30 days, with return ticket or return tickets to another country.

Laos Stay in Laos for no more than 30 days. If you enter more than 30 days, you must apply for a visa in advance, the temporary stay period can be extended up to 2 times, 30 days at a time.

Kyrgyzstan Unlimited length of stay.

Philippines Duration of stay is not more than 21 days, passport valid for at least 6 months and has a round-trip ticket or to another country.

Myanmar Duration of stay does not exceed 14 days, passport valid for use at least 6 months.

Indonesia Duration of stay does not exceed 30 days and cannot be extended.

Brunei Duration of stay not exceeding 14 days.

Panama Duration of stay 180 days.

Ecuador Maximum length of stay is 90 days.

St Vincent and the Grenadines Islands There is a round-trip air ticket and proving sufficient funds to pay for the trip.

Haiti Maximum stay of 90 days.

Turks and Caicos Islands Duration of stay does not exceed 30 days, extended once more.

Japan Simplify visa application procedure.

Kenya Duration of stay is within 03 months.

South Korea There is no need for a visa to visit Jeju Island.

Madagascar Duration of stay for 90 days.

Mali There are no conditions.

Marshall Islands Duration of stay does not exceed 90 days.

Mauritania No conditions.

Papua New Guinea Duration of stay does not exceed 60 days.

Saint Lucia Duration of stay is within 6 weeks.

Comoros No conditions. Seychelles Duration of stay does not exceed 60 days.

Taiwan If you have a visa from the United States, Canada, Great Britain, Japan, Australia, New Zealand and European Schengen visa (including immigrant card) will be exempt from entry visa to Taiwan. The stay does not

exceed 30 days.

Tanzania Unconditional.

Togo Duration of stay is within 7 days.

Tajikistan Duration of stay for 45 days.

East Timor Present 100 USD for each entry and return flight ticket.

Zambia Duration of 90 days.

Nepal Duration of stay 90 days.

Sri Lanka Just apply for a visa online.

United Arab Emirates (UAE) Online visa applications are available.

Iran Duration of stay does not exceed 17 days.

Republic of Cabo Verde Issuing visas at the airport.

Republic of Guinea-Bissau Duration of stay 90 days.
