Baking soda is becoming more and more popular and familiar to consumers, but not everyone knows how to fully utilize their performance. Baking soda crystals are a solid, white, odorless and salty taste but usually we still see them in fine powder. Initially, baking soda was used by seafarers to marinate fish and keep fish fresh longer. Later, when technology developed, baking soda was more widely used in the food processing industry.

According to Bright Side, baking soda is an excellent substance, not only bringing a lot of benefits to humans, but also being environmentally friendly. In this article, we will introduce some effective **ways to use baking soda** to help you have a cleaner, tidy, tidy and healthier life.

Clean bed mattress

The mattress that we are laying on every day is the birthplace of countless bacteria, mold and dirt. Many people think that just changing the bed is enough but in reality it is not. Sweat, body fluids, dirt accumulating on the

mattress should contain many dangerous pathogens if not kept clean.



How to clean the mattress below can remove dirt, sweat, dead skin cells and unpleasant odors:

1. First, remove dirt from the mattress.
2. Open the baking soda box, add about 10-15 drops of your favorite essential oil, then cover the lid and shake it evenly (*to make the oil evenly spread, also let the lumps of powder dissolve*).
3. Sprinkle the whole box of mixed baking soda on the bed, rub it well and leave it for at least a few hours, preferably one day.
4. In the meantime, clean the surroundings or do whatever you want, and on time, use a vacuum cleaner to carefully remove the powder from the mattress. Being sucked up under the powder now has dirt, moisture, and dirt . so your cushion is really clean and fragrant.

Vacuuming the mattress helps remove dust, while baking soda is very effective in removing bacteria and vacuuming dirt. Please follow this tip as soon as possible. It not only helps clean the mattress but also protects the health of you and your family.

Stain dirt on carpet



Carpets are one of the most difficult to clean household items due to their materials and construction. To clean the carpet quickly, clean, and out of smell, rub the stain with a mixture of 1 tablespoon baking soda and 1 tablespoon washing powder (*optional*). Then, pour 1 cup of warm water and add 4-5 tablespoons of vinegar 9%. Mix well and place in a water spray.

1. Vacuum on soft carpets or furniture.
2. Spray the solution for 5-10 seconds, then use the sponge to remove the liquid (*if necessary, rub the area that has been contaminated*). Repeat until you get the results you want, but make sure the liquid doesn't get in the fabric.
