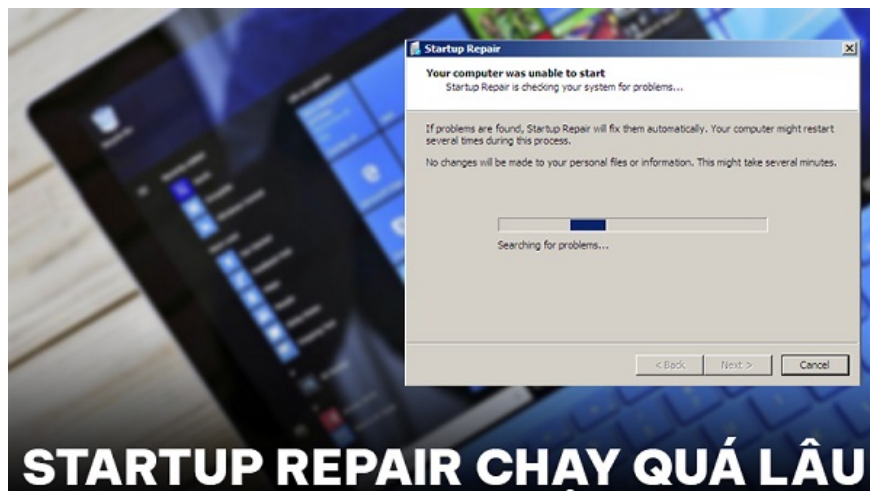
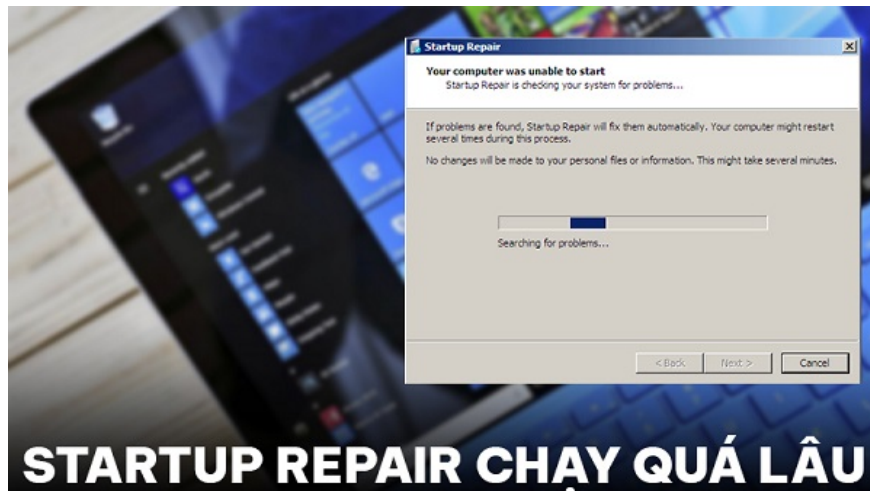


What to do when Startup Repair takes too long?

What to do if Startup Repair takes too long? If your computer is experiencing this, follow the article!

If you have used your computer for a long time, you must have seen the Startup Repair window a few times. Normally, this window will only appear for a moment. Then it will automatically close and the computer will operate normally again. However, there are cases where the **Startup Repair window runs for too long** and makes us unable to use the computer.

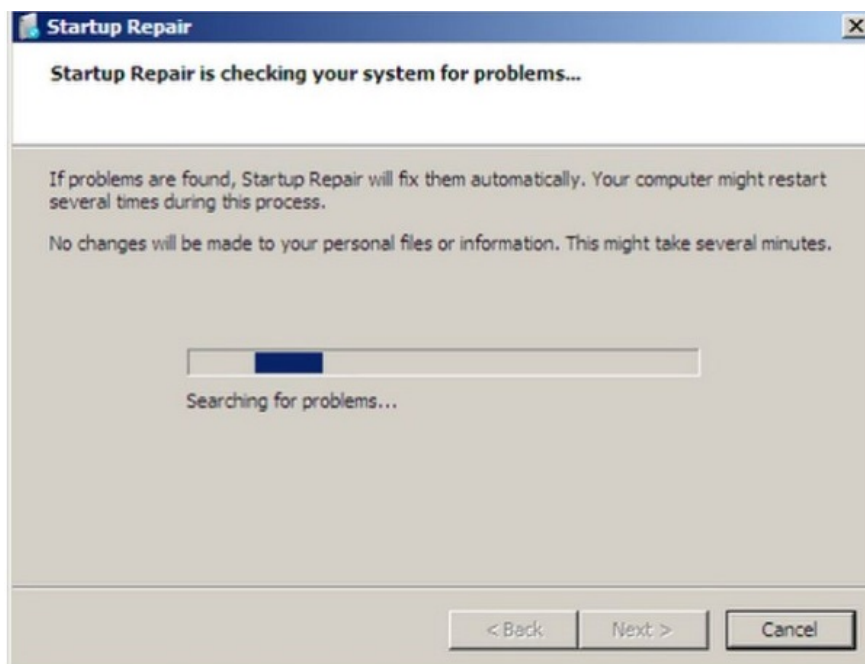
In case your computer is also facing this annoying situation, let's find a way to fix it!

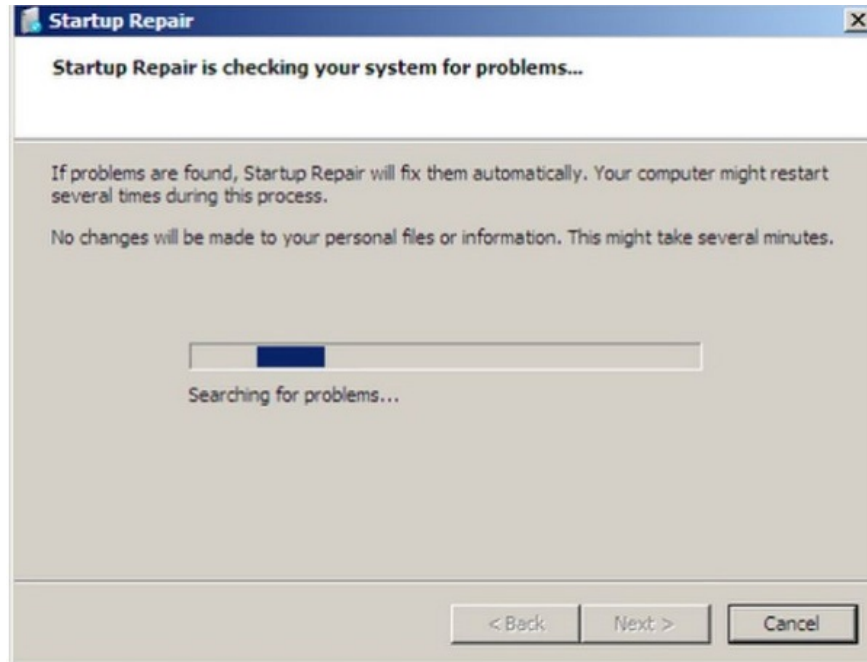


What is Startup Repair and why does it take so long to run?

If you do not know, Startup Repair is a software built into the Windows system. This software will be used to handle errors when the computer has problems during startup. Depending on the problem, Startup Repair will have different error fixing times. With serious problems, this feature may take a long time (about several hours) to fix the error.

Although it is a very powerful and useful software. However, there are times when startup repair cannot fix the error. At this time, no matter how long you wait, the Startup Repair screen will not disappear. The main cause of this problem may be due to the Windows system missing important files, due to the user deleting the wrong file, due to a hard drive failure or it may also be due to a virus attack.





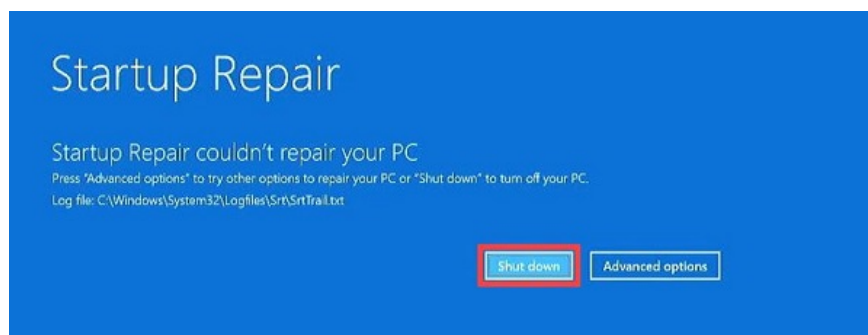
How to fix when Startup Repair takes too long on Win 10 and Win 11

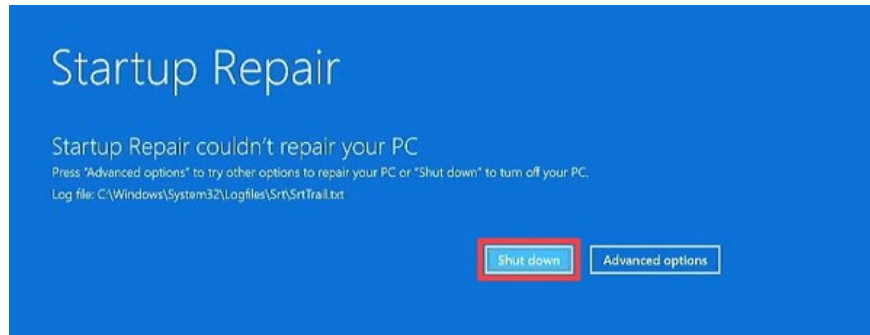
If Startup Repair runs too slowly, we will not be able to use the computer. Of course, this is something that no computer user wants to encounter. In case you are looking for how to fix Startup Repair Win 10 error or how to fix Startup Repair Win 11 error, you can try some of the measures below.

1/ Try to restart your computer

Normally, you only need to wait a few minutes for the Startup Repair window to close automatically. But if you have waited too many hours and Startup Repair is still running, it is best to find a way to restart your computer. To do this, try holding down the computer's **power** button continuously for a few seconds until the screen turns off, then release it. If that doesn't work, you can try unplugging the PC or removing the laptop battery and then reinstalling it.

Note: If you see the message *startup repair couldn't repair your pc windows 11*, you can also select the **shutdown** button as shown below. If restarting still has the error, continue to the next methods.

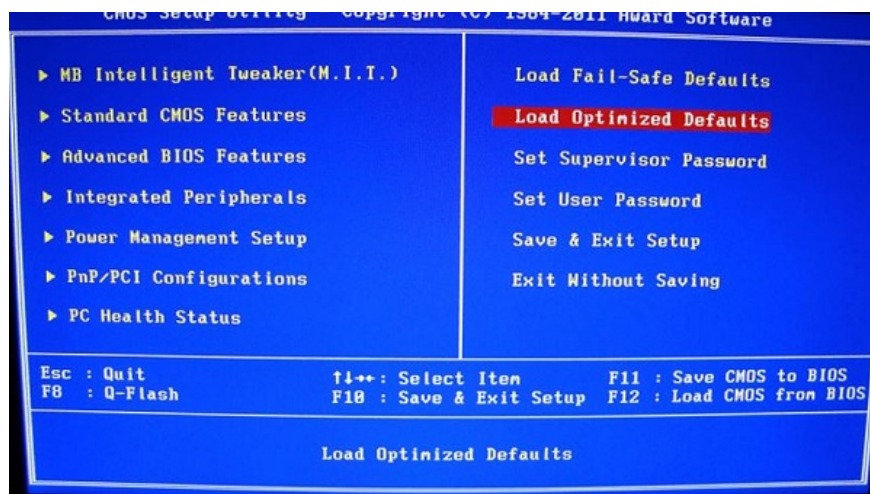


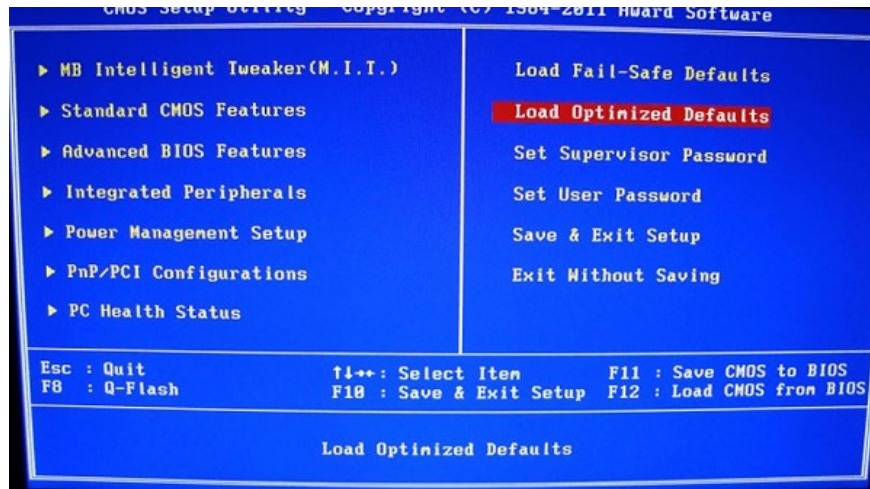


2/ Reset bios

Resetting the bios is also one of the commonly used methods to fix the error of Startup Repair running for a long time. To do this, you first need to restart the computer. During the boot process, continuously press the function key to access the bios. Usually it will be the delete or F12 key, to be sure, you should learn how to enable the bios on the type of motherboard you are using.

After entering the BIOS, find and select items such as *Reset to default*, *Load factory defaults*, *Load setup defaults* or *Clear BIOS settings* . After pressing **enter** and selecting **yes** to confirm, the BIOS on the computer will be reset to its original state. Now try restarting the computer!





3/ Reinstall Windows

Finally, when all measures are ineffective, reinstalling Windows will be the best solution for you. Currently, with the support of high-speed hard drives. Installing Windows will not take too much time. If you have enough knowledge and equipment, you can install Windows at home. If you are not sure you can do it yourself, take your computer to a repair center for support.
