Jotun

Developed and published by Thunder Lotus Games, Jotun's story revolves around the female Viking named Thora after an unnamed death. She had to fight against Jötunn to prove herself to the gods and to Valhalla, heaven of true warriors.



Using hand-drawn graphics and cut scenes running in colorful frames helps the Nordic world in the game be depicted extremely nicely. Along with the unique fighting and puzzle gameplay, the vast environment to explore and the great boss battles, Jotun is definitely an indie game worth a try.

Munin

Continuing to be an indie game, this time from the developer Gojira. Munin is about a character of the same name, Odin's messenger. After Loki took his wings, Munin had to set out on his own to regain his lost wings. Munin is a 2D platform game that combines puzzles. Players will have to rotate certain parts of the environment, while collecting enough feathers to be able to advance to the next level.



The game features a fairly simple hand-drawn graphics and a rich Nordic cultural network. If you do not have too high requirements in the plot and graphics that are not strong points of the game, Munin is a good choice.
