

What will Bill Gates do to fight COVID-19 if it is the US President?

If Bill Gates was the US President right now, he would prioritize keeping people across the United States in isolation to 'smooth the curve' of the COVID-19 pandemic.

"The clear message will be that we have no choice to maintain this isolation and that will continue for a while. In the case of China, it has lasted for six weeks. , so we have to prepare for that and do it well, "Bill Gates told Chris Anderson, the TED Talks manager on Tuesday.

According to Gates, "If you're doing good isolation across the country, in about 20 days, you'll see the number of new infections and deaths actually change, that is, decrease, and that's a sign for see you are on the right track ".



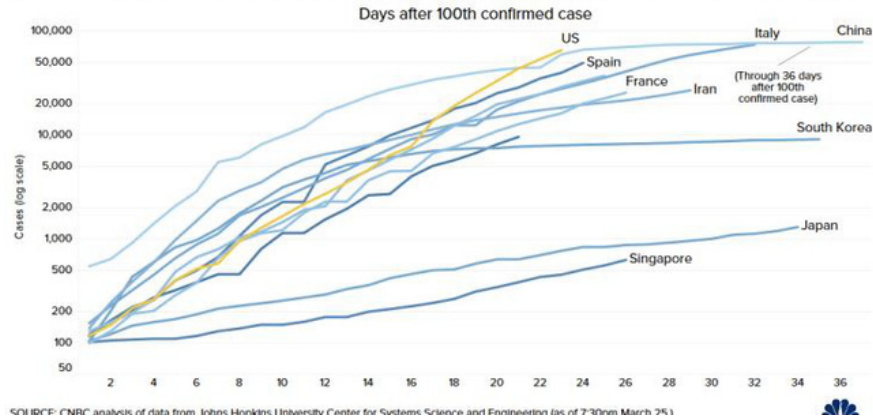
Gates also emphasized: "This will not be easy. We need a clear message about that," he said.

Currently, at least 179 million people in 18 states, 31 counties and 13 cities are being encouraged to stay home, according to a New York Times tally.

According to the corona virus resource center at Johns Hopkins University, the number of new cases in the US is still getting higher. If you try to make a comparison, this curve has generally been "flattened" in China and South Korea, as the chart below shows.

The pace of the coronavirus outbreak

The number of new cases of coronavirus began to slow in China and South Korea about three weeks after the first 100 cases had been reported. In the U.S., the number of reported cases has been rising rapidly, in part because test kits have become more widely available. (Each country curve starts on the day after the first hundred cases were reported. The steeper the curve, the faster the virus is spreading.)



As co-founder of the Bill and Melinda Gates Foundation, Gates has significant experience in combating infectious diseases such as malaria, HIV and polio.

Gates' comments came when President Donald Trump announced he wanted businesses in the US to reopen on Easter, April 12.

"America will be open again - very soon, much earlier than the 3 or 4 months someone has suggested. We can't let the treatment get worse. We can do two things at once." ", Mr. Trump said at a press conference on Monday.

"You can't just come and say shut down America, the biggest, most successful country in the world," he said, adding that a major recession would cost life.

On the other hand, health experts believe that the reopening of businesses and schools at this time is too early, which could have detrimental consequences for the spread of the pandemic.

"It is clear that Mr. Trump does not start from reality," Dr. Tina Tan, a board member of the American Society of Infectious Diseases and an employee at Lurie Children Hospital in Chicago, told CNBC.

Gates also emphasized that it is important to prioritize human health over money.

"It is tragic that the economic effects of this epidemic are so serious. There has never been something like this happening to the economy in our time. However, bring the economy back and making money is something that can easily be reversed rather than bringing people back to life, so we will have to suffer the economic pain - the great pain - to minimize the pain of disease and dead".
