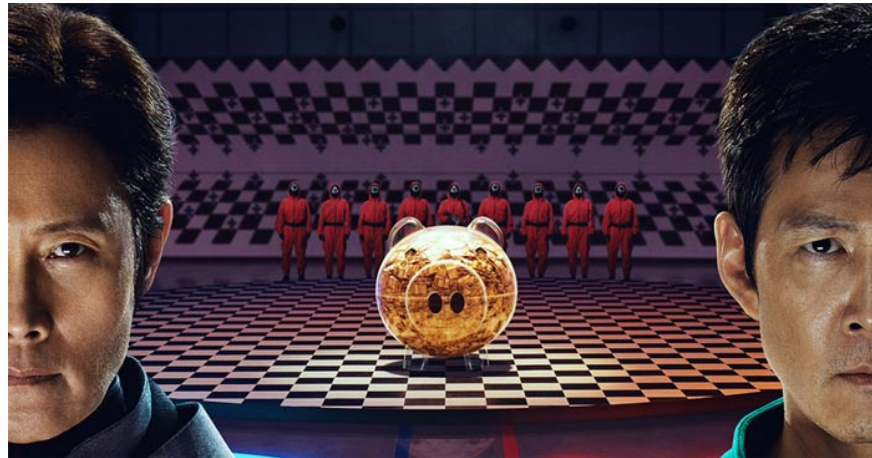

Squid Game 2 Cast

The cast of Squid Game season 2 has been partially confirmed, including a character whose fate was uncertain in the first season of Squid Game. A casting video debuted at the Netflix Tudum event and revealed that the surviving members from season 1 will be returning for season 2. These include Lee Jung-jae as Seong Gi-hun, Lee Byeong-Heon as Hwang In-ho, Wi Ha-Joon as Hwang Jun-ho, and Gong Yoo as a recruiter for the game.

What is the main content of Squid Game 2?

The ending of Squid Game season 1 certainly left the door open for a sequel, although many wondered if the setting would be drastically different and not as focused on the actual game. and that Front Man's intention was never to kill his brother, but to save him.
