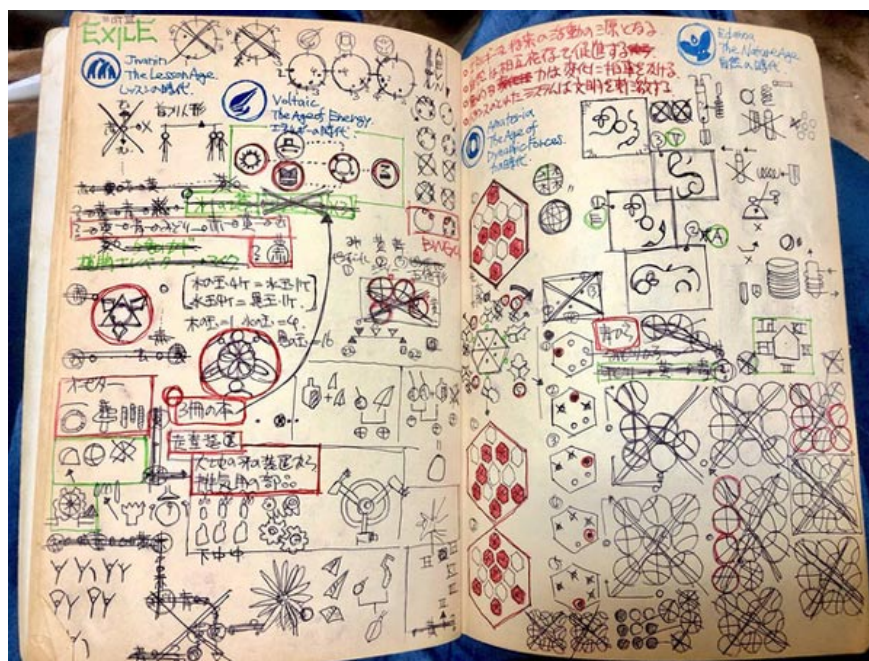

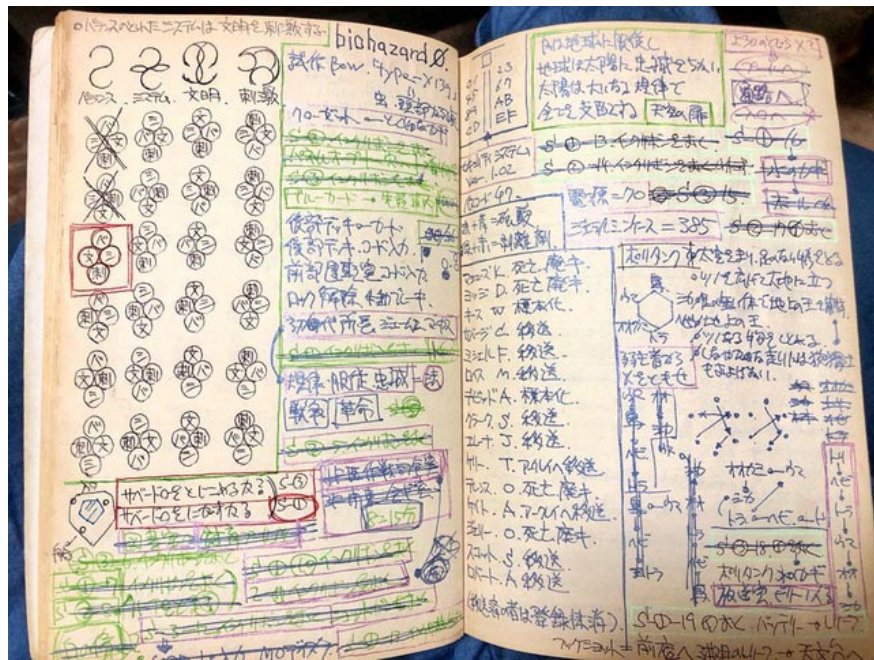
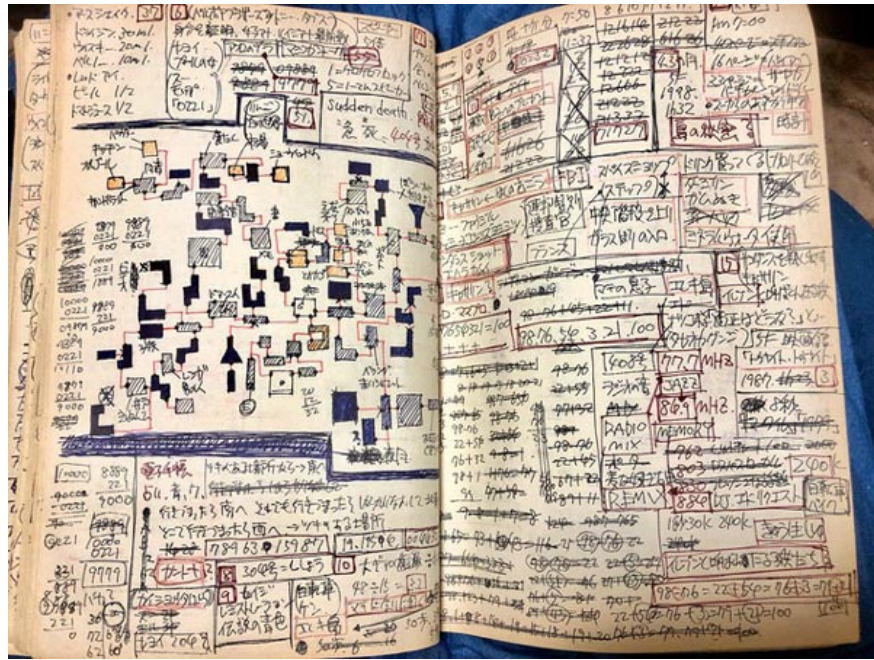
Recently, Ishikoro18, a Twitter user in Japan, has shared an incredibly creative guide book for his father that many people couldn't help but be surprised.
