

Where to place ornamental plants in the house is good for feng shui?

We invite you to read the article below to know where to place indoor plants that are good for feng shui.

1. Main gate

The main door of the house is the place to receive the main energy flows of the house, so it is necessary to carefully choose the type of tree to be placed in this location to avoid creating conditions for bringing bad energy flows into the indoor space.

If the door is made of wood, you should choose ornamental plants with large, straight, cylindrical pillars symbolizing the Wood element on both sides to create balance and attraction for the house.

If the door is made of metal (symbolizing the Metal element), you should choose ornamental plants with flexible stems, small and luxuriant leaves (symbolizing the Water element) to create balance and receive positive energy flows. pole for the house.

2. Entrance to the house

The entrance to the house is where you welcome guests, where drafts and good things come to your family. Therefore, this is a good location to place feng shui ornamental plants.

At the entrance to the house, you can place small pots of plants such as bamboo, etc. This location is not suitable for growing large trees with wide canopy, do not plant one tree alone or too many trees. Some types of ornamental plants that should not be placed in this location include mulberry trees, poplar trees, willow trees, cypress trees, banyan trees.

3. Living room



The living room is a place that attracts fortune and shows the homeowner's style, so it is very suitable for placing feng shui ornamental plants. Ornamental plants that should be placed in the living room are plants such as honeysuckle, goldenrod, money tree, ivy.

In the living room, you should choose plants with round leaves and place them in the corner of the room, on the table, TV shelf or cabinet to help positive energy flow easily in the room and throughout the house.

Note, do not place plants blocking the path or under the air conditioner. Avoid placing plants in the North, Southwest and Northeast directions in the room.

4. Working room

In the office and reading room areas, you should only choose small ornamental plants such as bonsai or lucky bamboo.

5. Bedroom



Ornamental plants placed in the bedroom need to choose plants that create a feeling of closeness and warmth, are not harmful to health, and have a gentle scent, if any.

Do not place the plant right at the head of the bed. And you should only choose small, easy-to-care-for table ornamental plants that have the ability to absorb toxic gases such as snake tongue, aloe vera, pentaphyllum, orchid, Van truc.

6. Dining room

The dining room is the main gathering place for family members. Therefore, you should choose small plants that do not have too strong a scent, creating a feeling of warmth, closeness, comfort and joy.

Some suggested ornamental plants in the dining room are lavender, rosemary, peony, mint, basil.

7. Bathroom



In the bathroom, just place a few potted plants on a small table or a vase of flowers for decoration. You should choose plants that have good vitality and can withstand the sun. Avoid choosing large plants that take up space and easily create an environment for bacteria and mosquitoes to breed.

8. Stairs - skylight

In the area of ??the stairs or at the foot of the stairs or skylight, you should choose ornamental plants with large cylindrical stems and many leaves to create a feeling of safety and hide hidden corners of the stairs.

9. Corridor

The corridor between spaces is the main circulation place for air and energy flows in the house. Therefore, in this area you should place ornamental plants that have good air circulation and whose colors are not too bright.

10. Balcony, windows



Balconies or windows are also places to receive air and energy flows for the house. This area is suitable for placing trees with large, sturdy trunks and has the meaning of fortune. In addition, to increase prosperity and aesthetics, you can add small, beautiful, colorful and lush flower pots.
