Before achieving full independence, East Timor was part of the Portuguese empire for 500 years and about 24 years under Indonesian control.

The beaches in East Timor are quite deserted as there are very few tourists. Coming to East Timor, you can scuba dive around untouched coral reefs.

East Timor is one of the places with the best coffee in the world, with a taste unlike any other Asian coffee. 46% of East Timorese people's income depends on coffee.

Timor Leste is one of the poorest countries in the world, but people here are provided with free general education and healthcare. In addition, people in this country aged 60 and over receive a subsidy of 60 USD/month, while unemployment benefits are 90 USD/month.

Although poor, the cost of living in Timor Leste is very expensive, about 3 times higher than in Hanoi.

Timor Leste's passport is one of the most "valuable" passports in Southeast Asia, allowing you to travel to all countries in the Shenghen bloc within 3 months without needing a visa.

Timor Leste students must be able to use four basic languages ??at the same time when they finish high school: the native language Tetu, Portuguese, English and Bahasa Indonesia. English and Portuguese are the two official languages ??in state documents.
