Important principles when choosing a switch

Before choosing a switch, consider carefully:

Tactile feedback: When you touch and press the key down, you feel the elasticity or bounce of the key. This will be the first principle when choosing any keyboard, because no matter how many modern features it has, the important thing about a mechanical keyboard is still the typing feeling.

Audio feedback: Does it produce any sound after pressing the key? Also, what is your current work environment like, is it suitable for quiet switches or can it be accompanied by a clicking sound?

Actuation force: this is the force required from the hand's typing action to activate the key. Or otherwise known as whether the key is heavy or not. You need to clearly define the purpose of using a mechanical keyboard to make the right choice.

Which switch type is best for you?

There are many different types of switches for different mechanical keyboards. Some popular brands are: Realforce with Topre switches, Razer with Razer mechanical switches, Razer optical switches, Steelseries with Steelseries QX2 switches,. So, you can choose one of the following types of switches:

1. Clicky and Tactile.
2. Clickless and Tactile.
3. Linear and non-clicky.
4. Low-profile Switch.
5. Topre switch group: Soft-Tactile is a concept that only Topre switches have.

How to choose a switch for each user

If you are a gamer then Blue switch, Red switch or Low profile switch, Topre switch is best for you.

If you are a gamer who plays shooting games, low profile red and Red switch will be very suitable for you. Switch will help you press accurately and quickly.

If you are a gamer playing MOBA, strategy games like League of Legends and Dota 2, precise presses and key sequences in the right order can change the outcome of a match. You should use a blue switch mechanical keyboard because this is the type of switch that gives the most feedback to your hands and is very suitable. In addition, you can try a different type of switch, Topre, which is often used on Realforce keyboard products, which is also very suitable for you because this is an extremely sensitive switch. You just need to press the key to receive the command immediately or you can also customize the sensitivity of each key with some high-end Realforce versions.



If you are a person who is afraid of noise affecting the surrounding users, you should not choose Blue switch. The sound that this switch creates can make your space not quiet. Therefore, you should choose the following types of switches in order from the sound that is just enough to hear to the quietest: Glorious Panda, Brown switch, Red switch, low profile red switch, Black switch, Pink switch, Topre Switch.

If you enjoy your intense typing, a mechanical keyboard with Blue switches is worth a try. If you are a person who works with efficiency expressed by the number of letters, Blue, Brown, Red, Black, Low profile, Topre, Glorious Panda are all options.
