

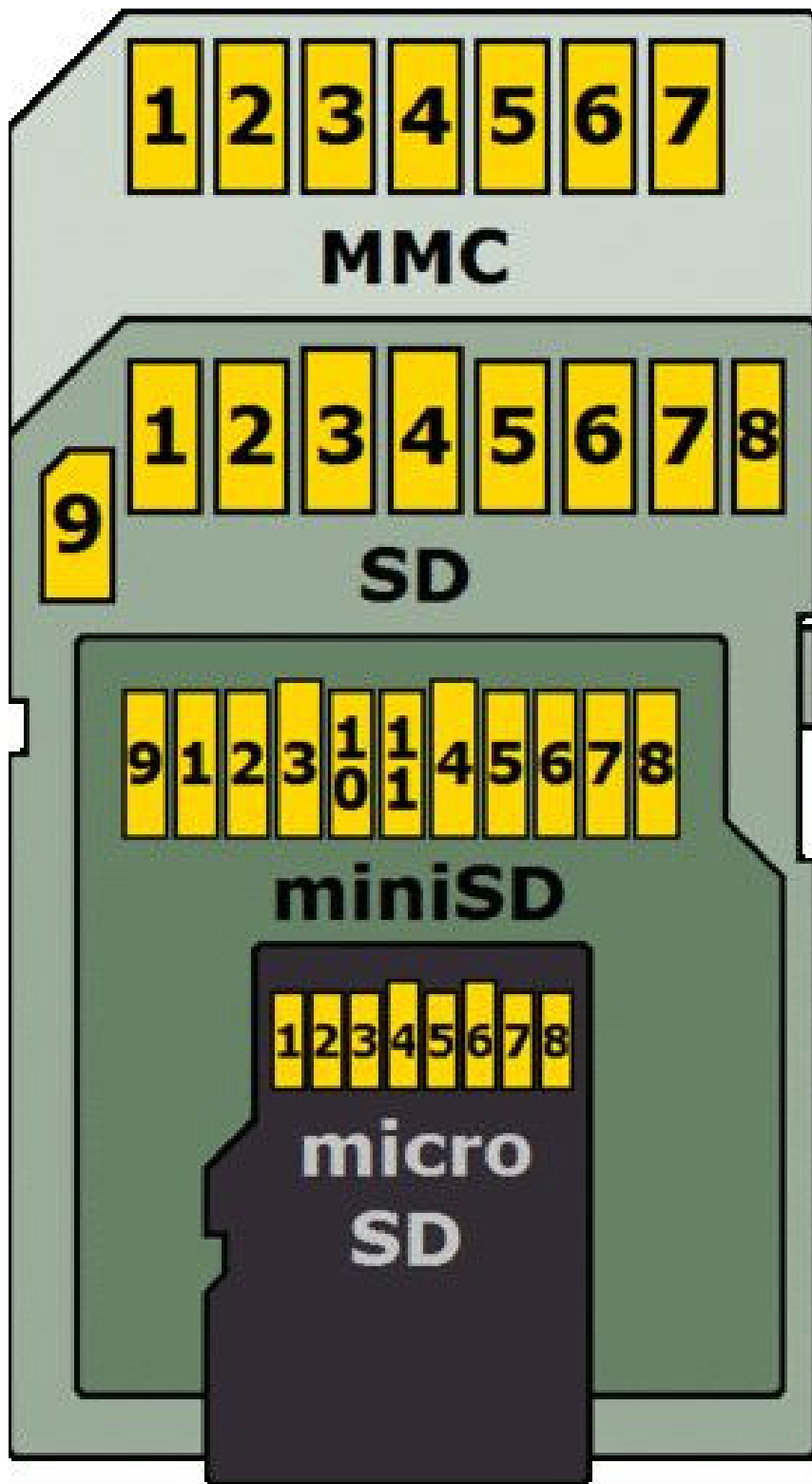
Why are contacts not identical on the memory card?

Question: Why are contacts not identical on the memory card?

You can look at the illustration below, some of the directories are stored longer than the others. Also SD memory card (in the second line from the top), the last digit in the phone book (number 8) is smaller than the remaining 7 digits . So why not all contacts are not the most size and location on the memory card.



Answer:

Contacts may be redundant or may be deleted in the previous or next section, contact data is connected or disconnected. In the Contacts section, numbers 8 and 9 are added to the MMC format when the size of the

memory card format is full.

In addition, because there is not enough space to fully display the contacts (maintain backward compatibility), it is possible to delete the first number of contacts when processing your name in MMC format and SD memory card.
