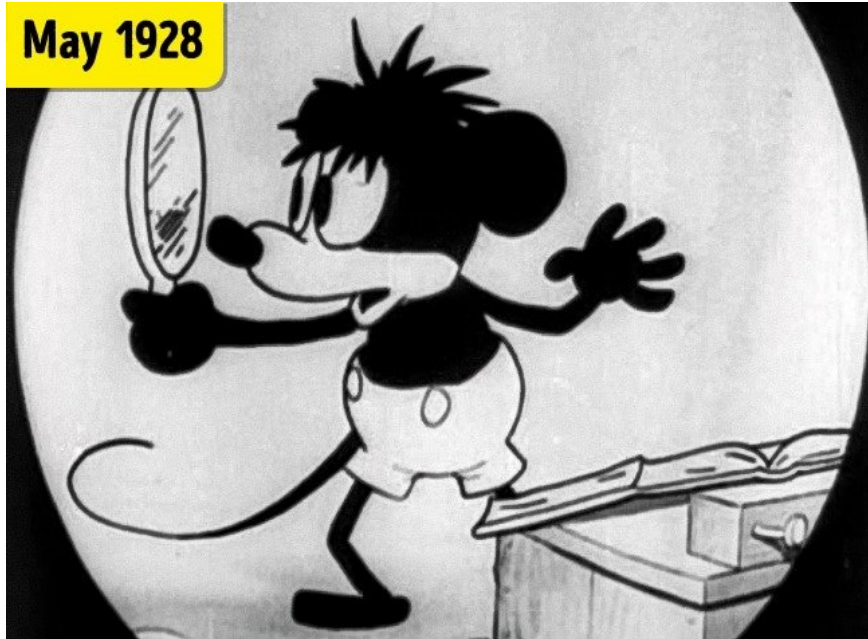

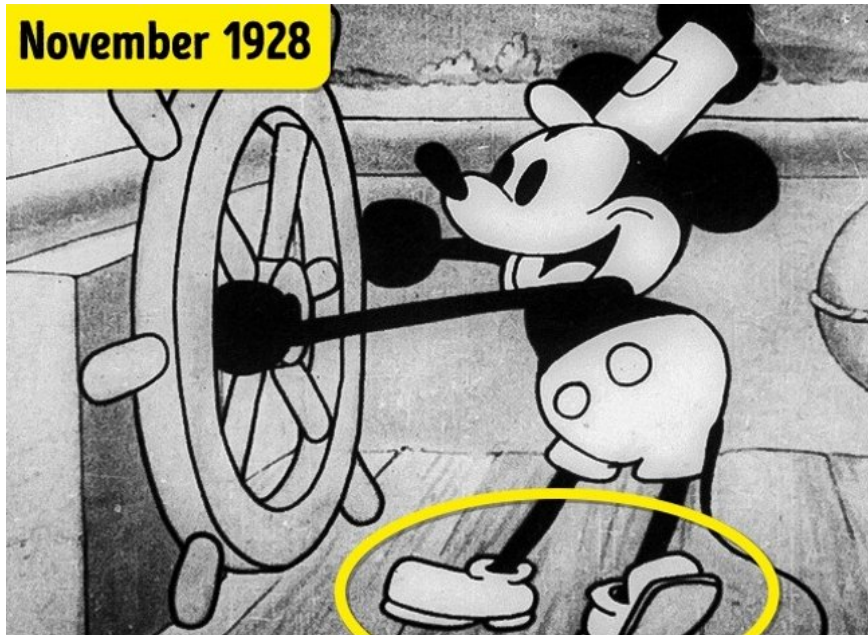
Mickey Mouse is the first Disney cartoon character to wear white gloves. Before the launch of the young audience, Mickey Mouse cartoon character first appeared in the short animated film " *Crazy Plane* " (*Plane Crazy*) in May 1928. At that time, Mickey's hand not wearing gloves and still the original black color. The white gloves were added only in March 1929, when the cartoon " *The Opry House* " officially premiered. And then, our Mickey Mouse begins to resonate in the world.

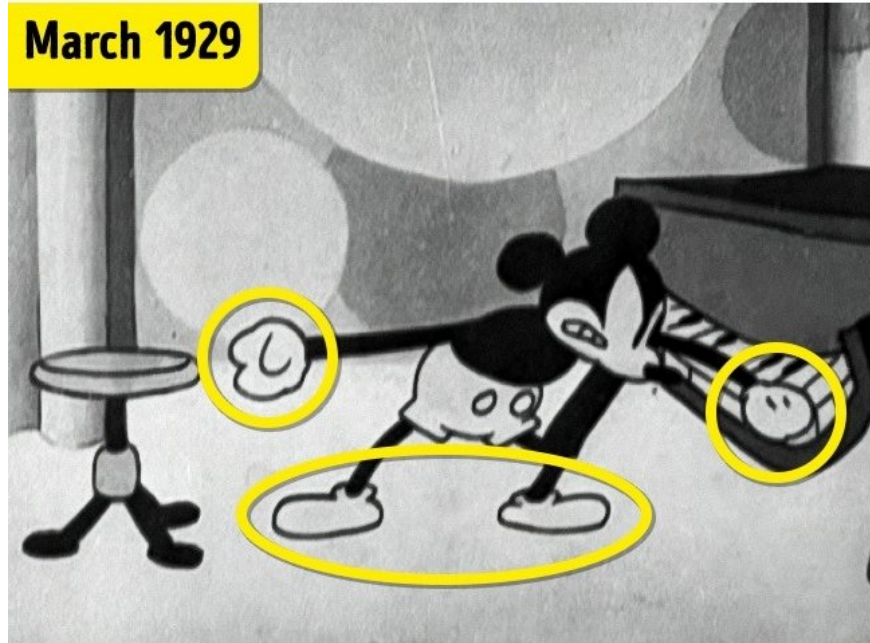

In fact, this is no coincidence, there are **three reasons why Walt Disney artists paint more white gloves for their cartoon characters** :

1. Save time

In the past, the period of the film making technology was stubborn, all frames were painted by hand. To get 1 second of film requires the artist to complete at least 24 frames (*24 images / s*). Meanwhile, the drawing of the characters' hands is not easy, moreover, if meticulousness will consume a lot of time and effort. Therefore, Walt Disney filmmakers decided to give cartoon characters gloves, which would save time for nail, hand joints . and the case of hand grasping just drawing circles with a few points are less expensive. To speed up work efficiency, cartoon characters began drawing characters without too much detail: big heads, big eyes, long limbs and all 4 fingers.

2. Create a contrast that helps the audience differentiate between the hands

In the early days, the animations were not as colorful as they are now, still in black-and-white form, making it difficult to distinguish certain parts, typically the hands on a whole black body. Only the way of wearing white gloves creates a clear contrast, helping the audience see the hand as well as the smooth, flexible movements of the hand.

3. Turn the cartoon character into . human

Walt Disney - the founder of the film company of the same name - once shared that he and his colleagues did not want Mickey Mouse characters with a mouse's hand because Mickey wanted to be like a human. So we let Mickey wear gloves.

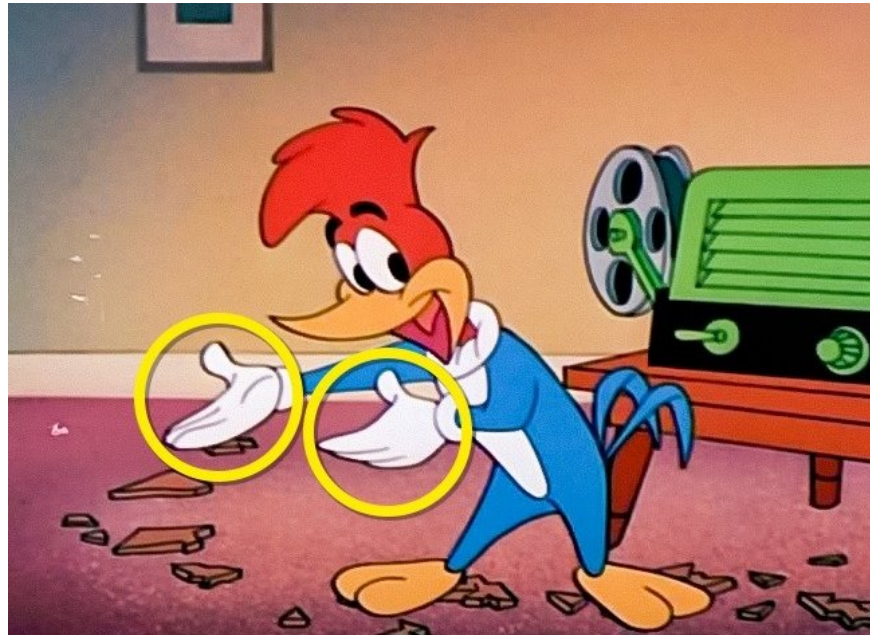

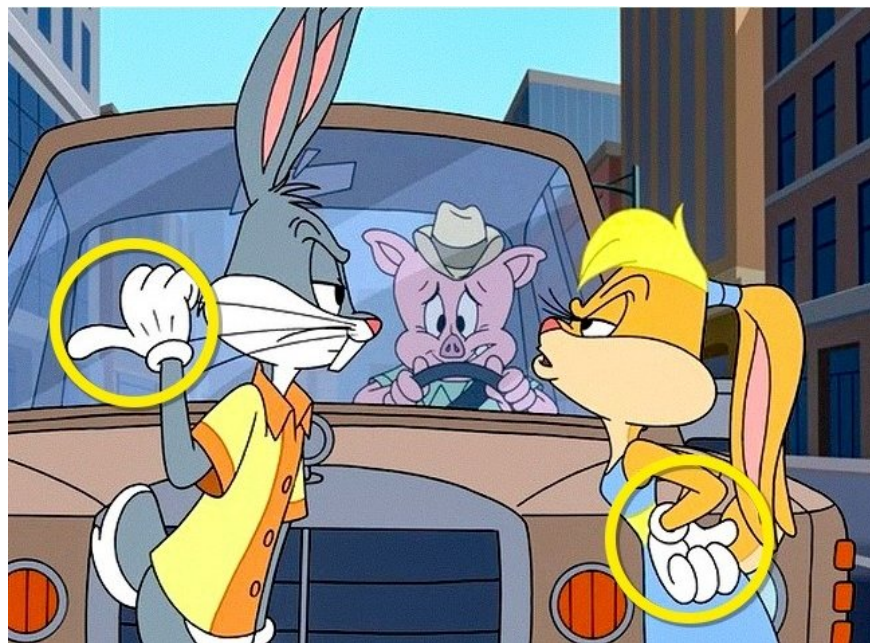
