

Why do players Among Us need the feature to automatically turn off voice chat?

Among Us players, you don't really have to communicate until someone presses Report or press the Emergency Meeting button. But this doesn't always work the way it should be in the game.

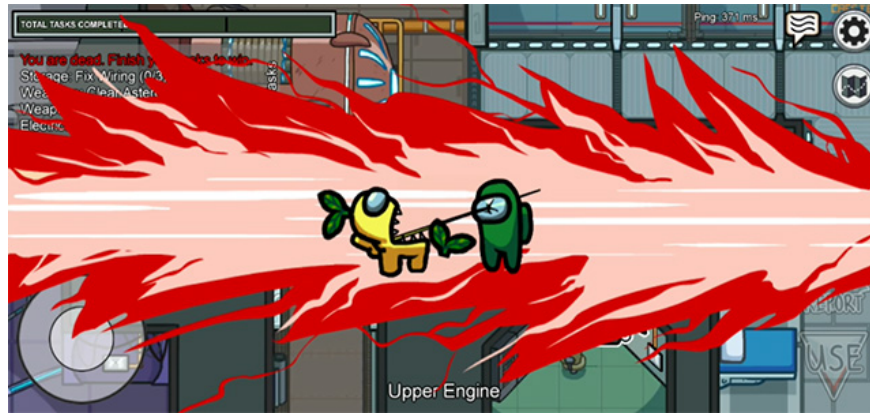

How do I automatically mute voice chat in Among Us?

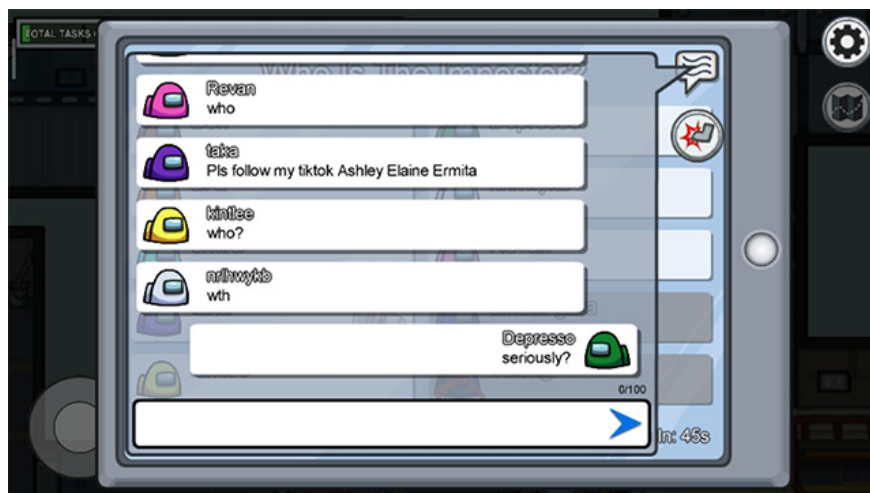
When playing and using Discord, players sometimes forget to silence themselves outside of the discussion. So having this option will prevent someone from blurting out something when killed.



Likewise, some people may forget to turn their mic back on when it's time to talk. And while this can be easily fixed, the fact that the game automatically turns on voice chat during meetings helps further streamline this.



Especially for those who are new to joining, they may not know when to turn their mic on and off. In addition, some troll players intentionally talk a lot, even revealing to everyone who just killed them. This will ruin everyone's game and the auto mute feature will get rid of all these problems.



Some players prefer texting instead of using voice chat when discussing. While the others wanted everyone to chat over the mic. Currently, there are many cases of players being suspicious just because they spend too much time typing and telling about what they have met with other players.



Typing speed on mobile phones usually has slower typing speed than keyboards on PCs. If everyone is okay with some people just texting, then there should be an easy voice-to-text method for players to be able to respond or justify to other players quickly and effectively.



Regardless of how the player chooses to communicate, the most important thing is to control yourself if you have to communicate with other players.
