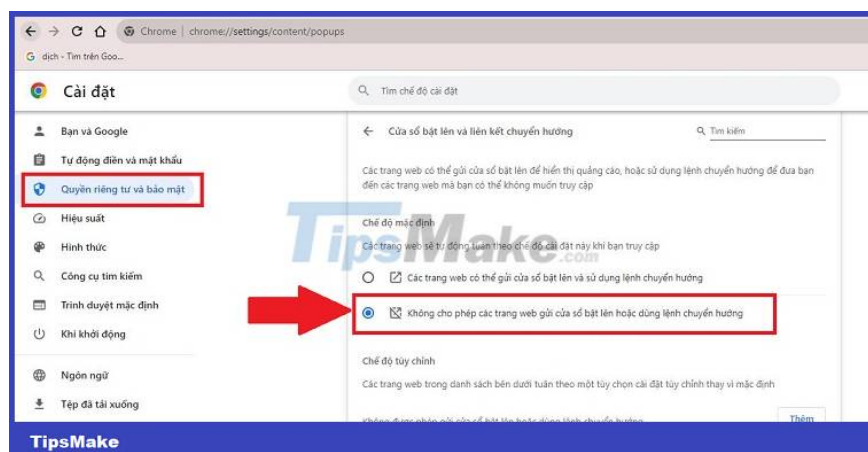
Find out how to quickly and simply fix your computer jumping tabs

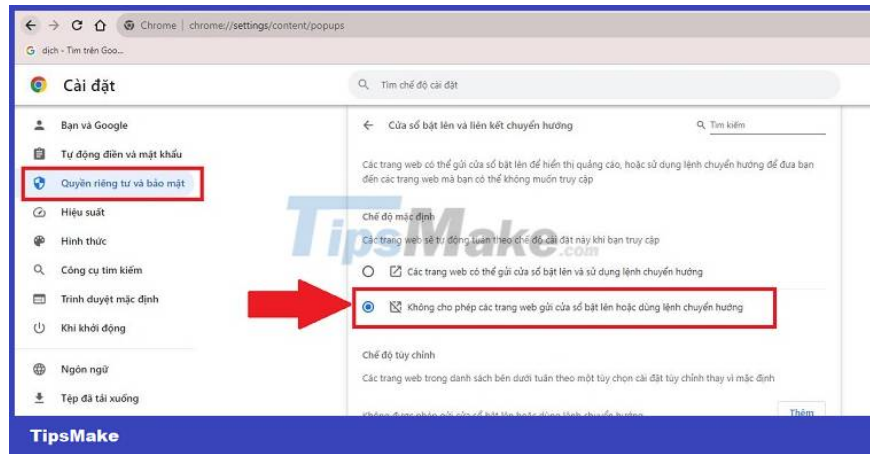
Although quite common, it is not uncommon for Chrome to experience errors during testing. The reason why Chrome automatically jumps to a new tab may be due to incorrect settings on this browser. Either you are accessing a website that contains advertising links, or you have visited unreliable websites that contain malicious advertising links and automatically jump tabs. The measures below will help you fix this problem in one fell swoop.

1/ Change Chrome browser settings to not automatically open tabs

One of the reasons why Chrome automatically opens a new tab is because the user has not set up this browser's settings. You need to do the following:

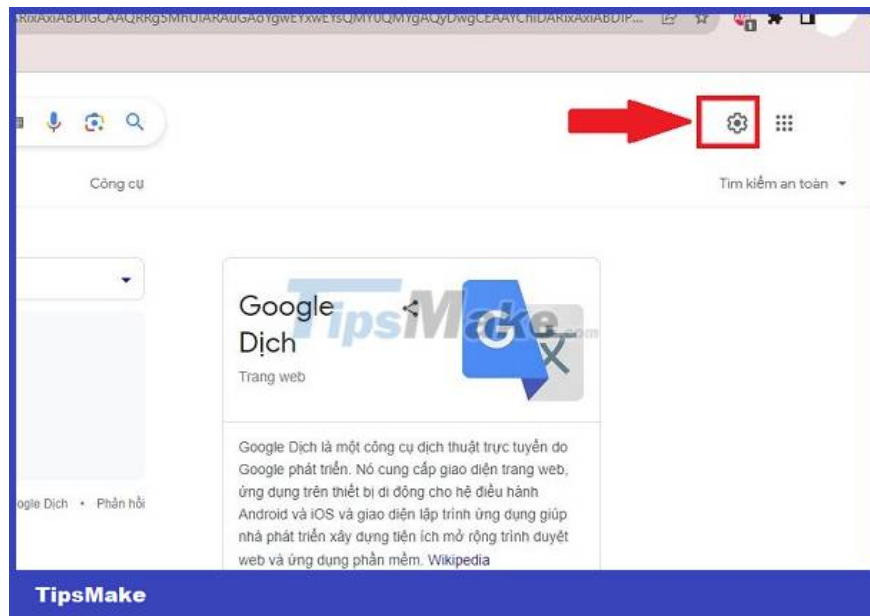
1. **Step 1** : The user opens Chrome on the computer > Click on the **3 dots in the right corner of the screen** > Select **Settings** .
2. **Step 2** : Click on **Privacy and security** in the left menu > Select **Website settings** at the bottom.
3. **B3** : Scroll down and click on the line '**Pop-ups and redirects**' > Tick the line '**Do not allow sites to send pop-ups or use redirects**'. If you often visit a website that every time you open it, many tabs often appear when you open Chrome > Go down to **Custom mode** > Add that website to the '**Do not allow.**' section.



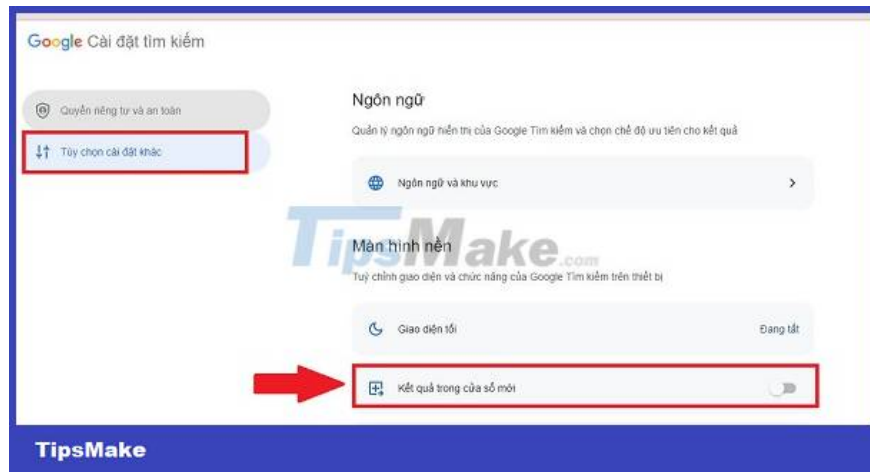


2/ Adjust search settings

1. **Step 1** : Open Chrome > Type any keyword to search > On the results display page, click the gear settings icon in the top right corner of the screen.



1. **Step 2** : When the tool displays, click **See all search settings** on the top line.
2. **Step 3** : Click on **Other settings options** in the left menu > Turn off **Results in new window** .



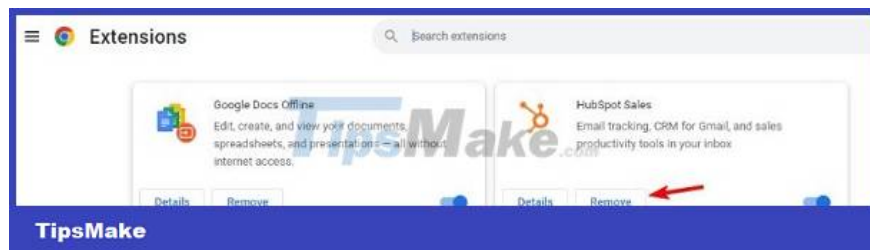
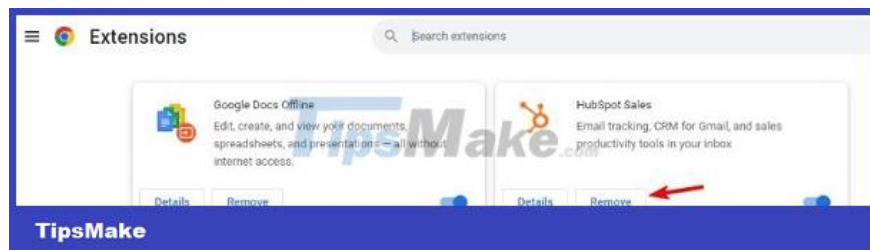
3/ Some ways to fix the error of Chrome automatically jumping to another tab

1. **Update Chrome** : Click the 3 dots in the top right corner of the browser > Select Help > About Google Chrome > Click Relaunch.

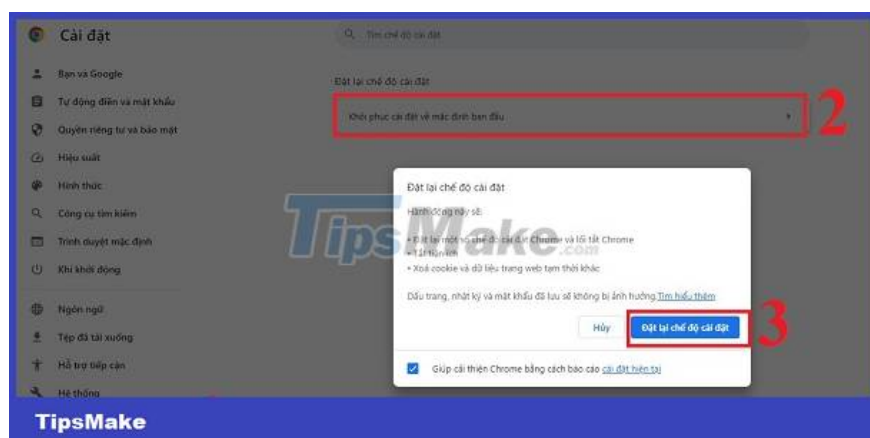


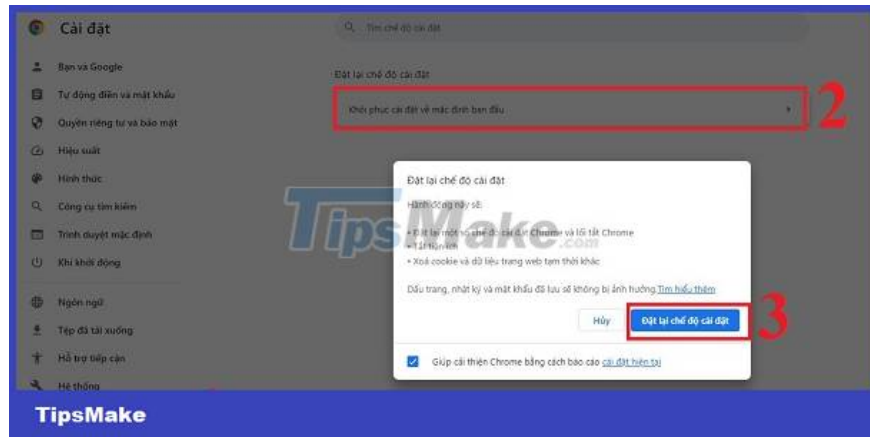


1. **Clear Chrome's cache and cookies** : Also in the Chrome Settings interface > Click on Privacy and security > Clear browsing data > Select time period > Clear data.
2. **Disable suspicious Chrome extensions** : Continue at Chrome Settings > Click on Extensions in the left list > Delete or turn off extensions that you suspect are causing the problem.



1. **Clean up Chrome** : Go to Chrome Settings > Click Reset settings > Restore settings to factory defaults > Reset settings.





4/ Close background applications and scan your PC

The fact that your computer automatically jumps tabs can also be caused by certain software, try checking and closing unnecessary background applications. Additionally, don't forget to scan your computer to see if there are viruses or not? Because it is also possible that the cause is caused by a toxic virus. Therefore, you should remove viruses if any for your device.

5/ Some other solutions when the computer automatically tabs

1. *As I shared, it is likely that the website you are visiting contains redirected ads. You accidentally clicked on it by mistake so you jumped to a new tab. Users can install ad blocking software for Chrome to fix it.*
2. *If none of the above solutions work, you should try uninstalling and reinstalling Chrome. This is a useful measure to fix this browser-related problem.*
