

Why doesn't recording time lapse on iPhone save?

Why doesn't recording time lapse on iPhone save?

Like most previous articles, before getting to the remedy. We will learn together why time lapse recording cannot be saved. To explain this unpleasant situation on the iPhone, we will have some of the following causes.

1/ Your iPhone is full of memory

When you want to save something on your iPhone or any other device. First of all we need to have enough free memory. And if you often use your iPhone to take photos, the possibility of memory being full is very high.

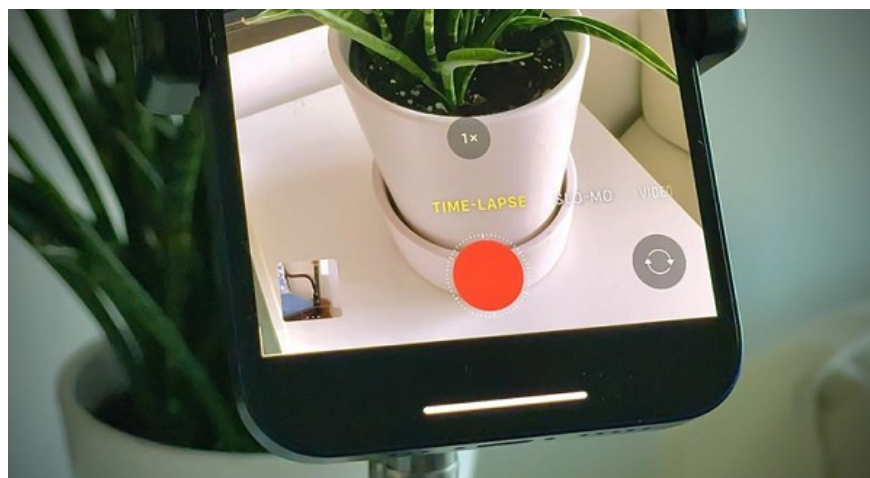
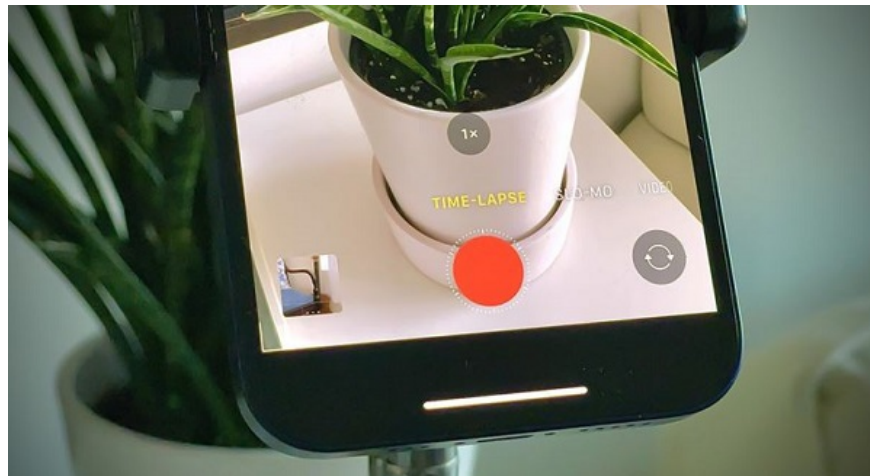
Therefore, when recording time lapse videos that are too long, the phone will not have enough space to store them.

2/ The phone is too hot

Although it is constantly being improved and upgraded, up to now, the overheating problem on the iPhone has not been resolved. Therefore, when using tasks such as playing heavy games or recording videos continuously for long periods of time. At this time, your iPhone will heat up quickly and may cause some components to fail during operation. The problem of lagging Time Lapse recording on iPhone or not being able to save time lapse video may also originate from here.

3/ Phone error

Finally, in addition to the above reasons, time lapse recording on iPhone does not save. It could also be because your iPhone itself is defective. However, rest assured, this actually happens very rarely.



How to handle when time lapse video cannot be saved on iPhone

When you realize that your iPhone cannot save time lapse videos, you don't need to worry too much. Here are a few ways to help you overcome this situation.

1: Clear memory

Because you record videos in high resolution, you need to have enough memory capacity to store them. If your iPhone is running out of space, you can delete unnecessary files. Or you can also upload data to storage services to free up memory. After you have enough free memory, try recording a short time lapse video to see if the error persists.

2: Cool down the phone

To ensure that the iPhone always operates stably and without errors when recording time lapse. Please be careful not to use your iPhone to record time lapse for too long a time. Ideally, you should record a video for about a few minutes. When you notice the device heating up, take a break and then continue recording video.



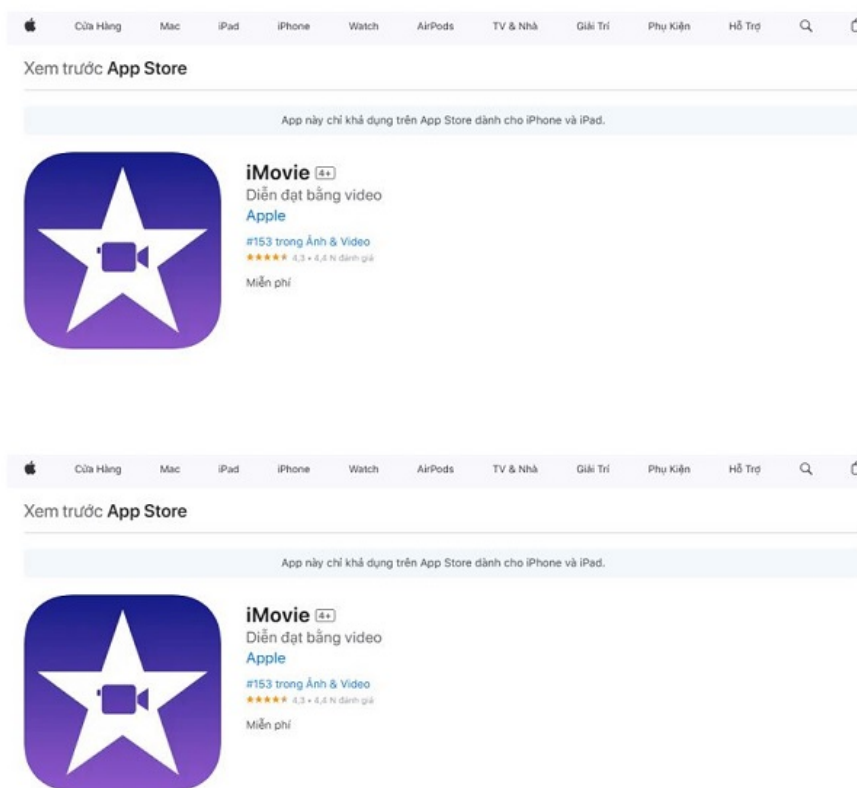
3: Restart the phone

Finally, try restarting your phone if the above 2 methods don't work. At the same time, if your iPhone has a new update, please update it immediately.

How to adjust time-lapse speed on iPhone

Except for cases where the iPhone does not save time lapse videos. Many people are also interested in how to adjust time-lapse speed on iPhone. However, the reality is that by default on the iPhone, there will be no software to help us do this.
