

# Why iOS 11.3 reports battery status 'Maintenance'?

After upgrading to iOS 11.3, many of you wonder about the performance reduction feature when the battery is in Maintenance status. So why is this message and what does it mean?

At dawn yesterday, Apple officially released iOS 11.3 and iOS users were able to update to iOS 11.3. It can be said that in this upgrade, the most anticipated feature is the ability to view the remaining battery capacity compared to when it was just released, this is a very good and easy thing for you to monitor the battery health and can go instead when needed. However, after upgrading to iOS 11.3, many of you wonder about the performance reduction feature when the battery is in "Maintenance" status. So what does this notice mean?

1. How to check battery status and turn off iOS 11.3 performance

Specifically, according to some of you, when iOS 11.3 update is officially successful, go to Settings (Battery)> Battery (Battery)> Battery Health (see Battery status), the item "Maintenance" appears. "and can not click to see as shown below.



By studying some Apple documents, there is no mention of this item. However, it is known that most of those who encounter the above situation have one thing in common: they have replaced batteries at outside stores. Thus, it is highly likely that users have replaced non-genuine batch batteries and Apple will not support this feature with the battery replacement.

Until now, it is unclear what other possibilities lead to this situation. If this feature is displayed, Maintenance for a battery is also a good test for you when buying a device.

One more question from some of you is why there is no Battery health in the Battery section of iPhone 5s. The answer is that Apple only provides features to view the device's battery status and turn off the iPhone slowdown feature for iPhone 6 and above, but unfortunately for iPhone 5s, "apple house" does not support the calculation. This feature.
