

# Why use Windows 10 Action Center instead of Settings app?

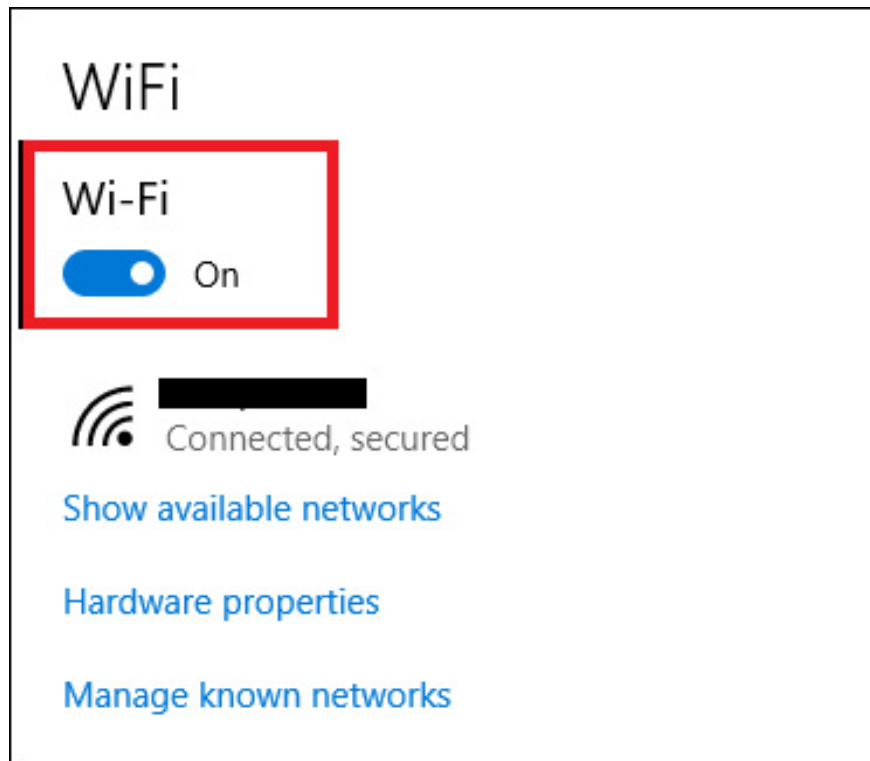

## 1. Wi-Fi

To turn on and off Wi-Fi without using Action Center (or Wi-Fi icon in the taskbar), you need to access **Start> Settings> Network and Internet> Wi-Fi** and adjust the slider on the screen.

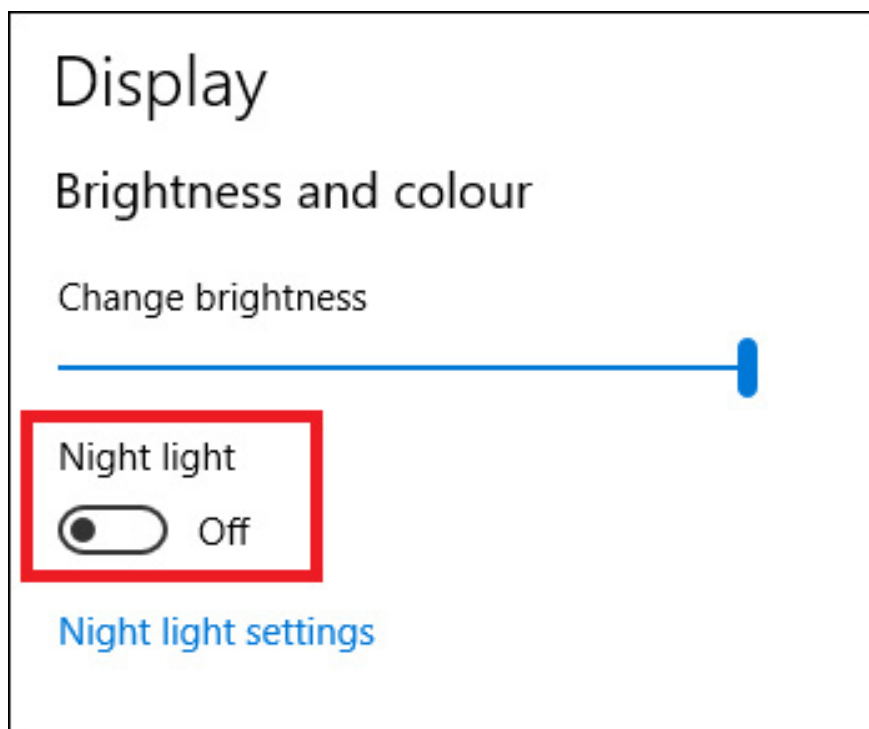


You can see that if you don't use the Action Center shortcut, you will spend 5 clicks, move and load time in the Settings app.

## 2. Night Light

Since Microsoft released Creators Update this spring, Windows 10 users have been able to use the built-in blue light filter. This feature will reduce the blue light on the computer, making it easy for you to use the device in the dark without fear of eyes.

To turn on Night Light mode in the Settings app, go to **Start> Settings> System> Display** and adjust the **Night Light** slider.



## 3. Bluetooth

If you do not use Action Center, you will waste 5 unnecessary clicks. If you want to turn Bluetooth on or off using the Settings application, you will need to access **Start> Settings> Devices> Bluetooth and Other Devices** and adjust the slider.
