Finally, in most cases, these devices are manufactured in sweatshops, where workers are often vulnerable, work in unsuitable conditions, and receive low wages. Therefore, users are advised to find ways to stay away from counterfeit products.

How to distinguish fake iPhones when buying online

So how can you determine whether an iPhone is a fake or not? The article below will analyze for users how to prevent it, especially when buying an iPhone online with many bargain prices that people cannot refuse.

Price and seller

To know whether an iPhone is original or not, the first thing users need to be wary of is extreme offers. Before deciding on a product, find out the price of that device at Apple or official suppliers. If the iPhone is priced too

low, users could be scammed. These attractive prices do not necessarily come from an individual but can also come from small businesses selling counterfeit products.

Counterfeit iPhones are often very cheap.

For the seller, users need to pay attention to whether the seller applies return conditions if the product is defective. Based on the answer from the seller, users can determine whether the product is real or fake.

Feeling in hand

If the above information is guaranteed to be reliable, the next path that users need to take is considered more difficult, which is the steps to determine the authenticity of the device. Below are notes that users should refer to before making a transaction:

- Visually evaluate the device: In this case, it will be difficult for users to detect whether the iPhone is fake or not when looking at the device at a glance. Parts such as screens and chassis that are loose are most likely counterfeit products because they were repaired or assembled at unofficial parties.

Holding it in your hand can help identify fake or real product samples.

- Test the device: use the device for a few minutes by opening tabs in Safari, downloading and testing apps. If it is very slow, it may contain non-original parts. Try to sync it with your iCloud account, if that device cannot sync easily, usually caused by an Apple device authentication error.

- Original box and accessories: If the product does not include the accessories that Apple provides with purchase, it may be because the product has been assembled illegally, which is why its legality is questionable. is a questionable matter.

- Check the model, serial number on iPhone, and receipt: Both the model number and serial number appear on the back of the iPhone, so check that they match the device information .

In general, it is necessary in this situation not to get carried away with cheap iPhone offers, and above all, to consult with a friend who has bought a used iPhone and what it would cost to buy it from Apple itself. iPhones are very expensive products, so it's impossible to find them at very competitive prices unless they are iPhones that are many years old, such as the iPhone XR or iPhone 11.
