

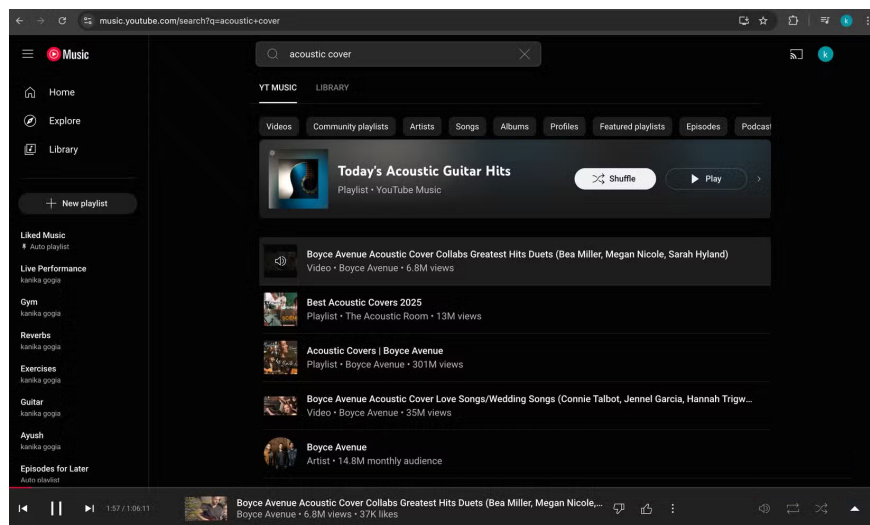
Why is YouTube Music better than Spotify and Apple Music?

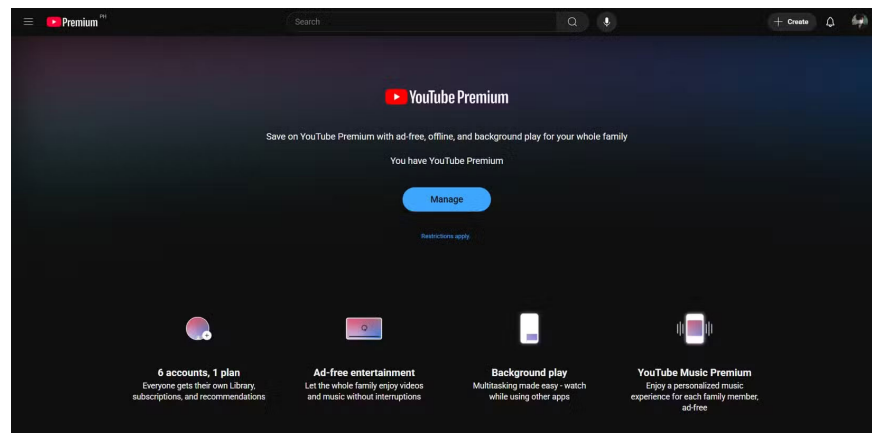

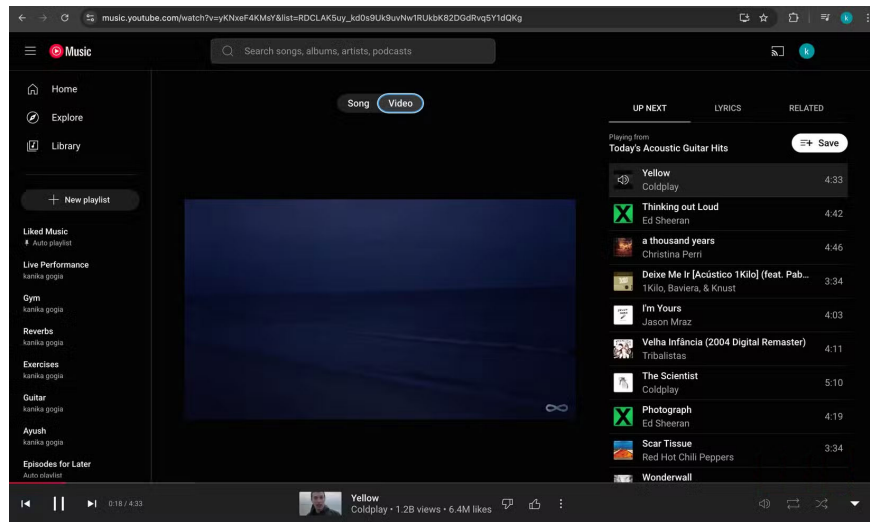

Audio and video are synchronized.

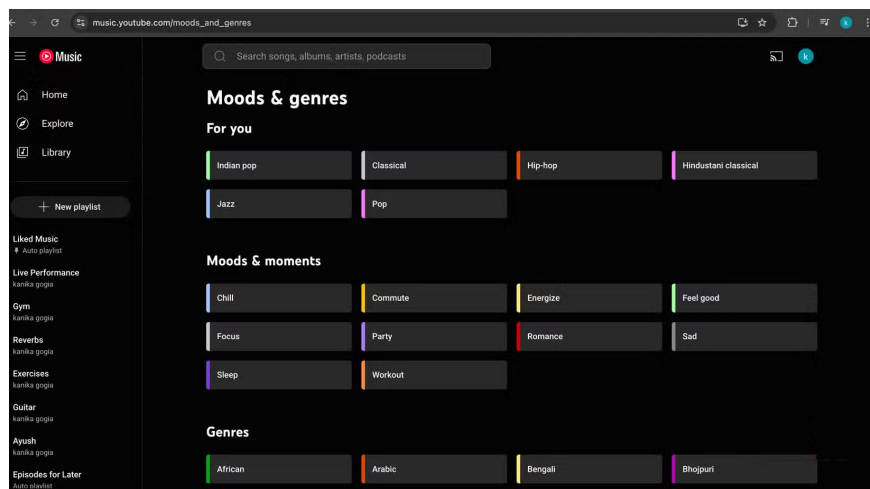

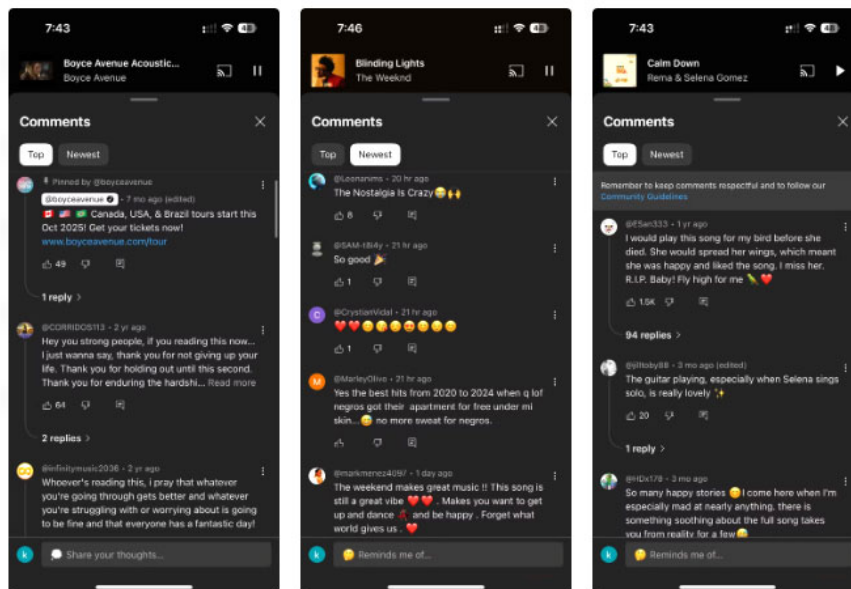
