

# Will the first Macbook model running ARM chip be released next year?

Apple is said to be preparing to launch new Mac devices running on ARM architecture chips sometime next year.

If you are an iFan or someone who is interested in the computer market in general and Mac products in particular, you've probably heard this before. Apple is said to be preparing to launch new Mac devices running on ARM architecture chips sometime next year. In fact, this kind of rumor has been around for many years, however, it has just been reaffirmed by analyst Ming-Chi Kuo - famous for his extremely accurate judgment. about Apple products, and the prestigious Bloomberg magazine. These can be considered as reliable facilities. So what's so remarkable about a Macbook ARM?

A new report released by Bloomberg indicates that Apple is preparing a total of three of its own processors to be ready on Mac family products. The chipsets are likely to be based on the Apple A14 Bionic processor that Apple will integrate inside the iPhone 12 models that will be released later this year. These chips will all be developed on the 5nm process and manufactured by TSMC as usual.

Also according to information revealed from Bloomberg, CEO Tim Cook and his colleagues are planning to launch at least one Mac device running on ARM chipsets next year, but the company will most likely switch the entire product line. according to the schedule. The transition to ARM processors will begin with the lower-cost models first, simply because the current ARM chips are still hard to deliver sufficiently powerful performance compared to Intel's high-end processors, which are currently Equipped on expensive Macs.

The first ARM processors for Mac are expected to own 12 cores, 8 of which are used for high-performance tasks and the remaining 4 cores handle basic tasks, such as Less intensive services run in the background. In the

future, the number of cores may increase, depending on actual efficiency and market demand.

Of course, it's still not 100% sure that Apple will launch ARM ARM devices in 2021, even if this rumor has been confirmed by reputable sources like Ming-Chi Kuo and Bloomberg. However, if these revelations come true, the laptop market in general next year will certainly have very interesting developments.
