

# Will the new champions of Truth Arena 2 coming season be champions in DTCL season 1?

These are the generals in the Arena of Truth season 1 will make crazy meta in Arena 2 of the arena if updated in the upcoming versions.

With Lucian back in the Arena of Truth 9.24 and upcoming Leona in DTCL 10.1. It seems likely that more DTCL Season 1 champions will return in Season 2. Even though it was their skill in Season 1 being brought to Season 2 like Brand.

If you look at it in detail, there are quite a lot of champions in DTCL season 1 that match in DTCL season 2 on Tribe and even match dtcl to suit the second generation tribe. Season 1 will probably appear in the Arena of Truth season 2.

## Which champions in DTCL Season 1 will be in DTCL Season 2?

### 1. Kennen

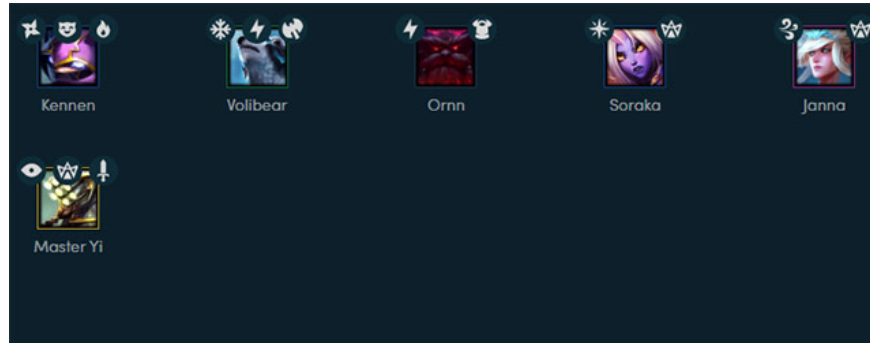


1. **Price:** 4 Gold
2. **Elemental:** Lightning
3. **Us:** Mystery
4. **Skill:** Thunderstorm

It is unclear for what reason that Kennen was not included in the current Arena of Truth season 2. Love it or hate it, Kennen has been used very often in season 1. Even in the squads that Kennen didn't make as the main carry.

With his Thunderstorm ability, Kennen can greatly affect the match.

Bringing Kennen back will be a great support for the Lightning clan to have a mid-range champion that works from the middle to the end of the game, and the player also has options for the Mysterious general. Imagine a squad with Kennen with Swordsman and Mystery or a Janna with Guardians + Lightning and how about having Kennen in it?



Obviously, Kennen's ability if he joins the Lightning team will be a more damaging champion than a tanker. However, he will have to stand at the top to be able to make the most of his skills and strength.

## 2. Blitzcrank



**Price:** 4 Gold

**Element:** Lightning, Steel

**Us:** Robot

**Skills:** Rocket Hands and Electromagnetic Field

Bringing this robot back to the Arena of Truth season 2 will definitely help you break the enemy squad easily and you will definitely love this. Or you might hate Blitzcrank if he's on the enemy team and grab your main carry, something that's common in DTCL Season 1.

Certainly in season 2, using Blitzcrank in the squad will be a bit late because his price is up to 4 gold. Blitzcrank not only has Rocket Hands to pull enemies like before, but also does damage them with the Electromagnetic Field like in League of Legends.



The return of the Robot System is very beneficial to Blitzcrank when he starts the round, he needs to use his skills right away. This will make Blitzcrank the perfect opponent for the champion in the back row like the Assassins, or maybe the top generals like Rage Battle.

Lightning element of Blitz will increase an option for gamers if the Lightning team build. Additionally the element of Steel will make Blitzcrank last longer when confronted with the main carry of the enemy team. In general, Blitzcrank will be an ideal champion if it enters the current meta game.

### 3. Gnar



**Price:** 2 Gold

**Elemental:** Earth

**Us:** Rage Battle

**Skill:** Stoned

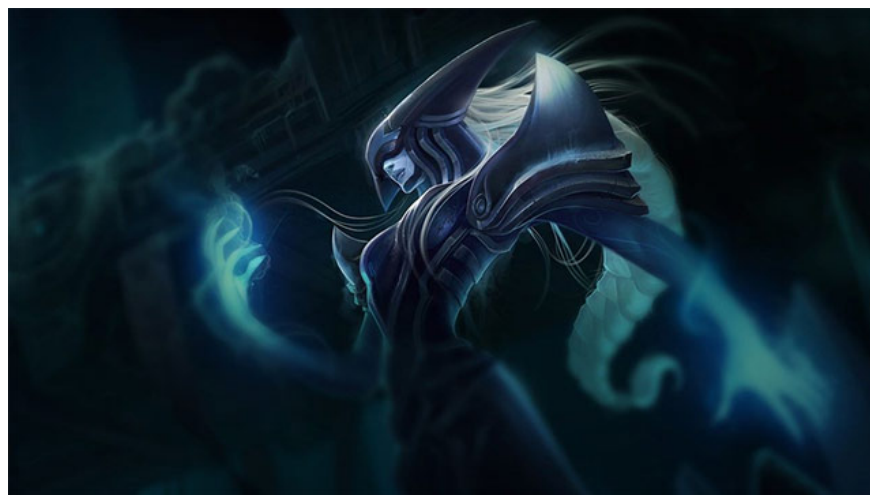
Gnar in the Arena of Truth season 1 is a champion used by quite a lot of people. The defense is quite popular with players, this may be the reason that Gnar may return in season 2.

Just like in season 1, Gnar will start the battle in normal form and transform once his mana bar is full. Gnar will then start throwing rocks at the enemy and that is Gnar's only skill use. For the time being, he will still be in Mega form and only use the ability to throw stones when the mana bar is full.



The most important thing if Gnar appears according to the specs above is that he only costs 2 gold. It is a low cost elemental champion, which can make the Earth elemental synergies a bit nerfed because the player who wants to have the Earth buff must have Taliyah + Malphite for 4 gold and have to go to the middle. game Malphite appeared. In short, Gnar will be the necessary and quite interesting addition to the Earth element and will be an additional choice for the Battle of Heroes.

## **Anivia / Lissandra**



**Price:** 3 Gold  
**Elemental:** Ice  
**Us:** Shamans

**Skill:** Snowstorm (Anivia) / Ice Shard (Lissandra)

This is a big surprise when both are not included in the Truth Arena this season when the version named Element Rise. Obviously, the Riot Games team cannot bring all of the Kingdoms generals from Season 1 to Season 2, but it's quite surprising that Anivia and Lissandra are not on the list of Ice Kingdom generals in Season 2.

Since both are quite similar, only one of them will be able to participate in the Arena of Truth season 2 this time.



The two abilities Snowstorm and Ice Fragment have similar characteristics when they are both a piece of ice fired like a bullet at an enemy champion. The Ice Fragment broke into pieces and hit anything behind its original target.

For this reason, Lissandra will probably attack better than Anivia. Either of these generals will make the Ice Kingdom and Wizards squad a whole new squad. Battle Heroes like Olaf and Volibear will join the wizards, making sure that this roster will shake the meta.

Those are the champions of the Arena of Truth season 1 likely to appear in the DTCL season 2. If these champions appear in the current meta game, it will definitely make the squad of Season 2 DTCL more interesting.
