This update will fix the blue screen error for some people who have upgraded to build 9879 as "*Fast Ring*" a few weeks ago. *Fast Ring* is a very fast *Windows 10 Technical Preview mode* so users will experience the latest changes from Microsoft, but it is not as stable as *Slow Ring* mode which is slower but safe. than.

It seems that Microsoft is trying to explore the situation and make sure everything is fine before distributing build 9879 to *Slow Ring* users . Switching between *Fast Ring* and *Slow Ring* can be tweaked in **PC Settings > Update and recovery > Preview builds** .
