Here are the major and significant changes of Windows 10X that are revealed in Microsoft's internal design document.

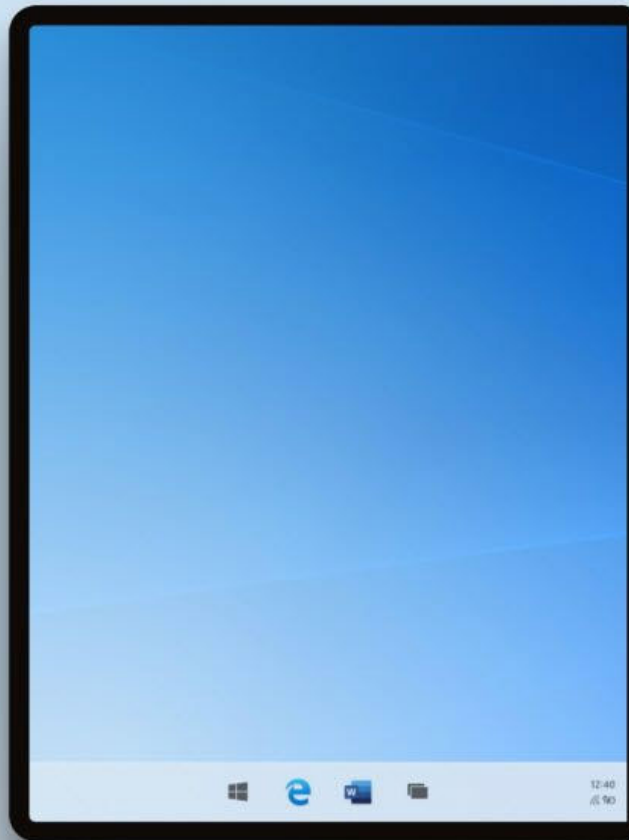

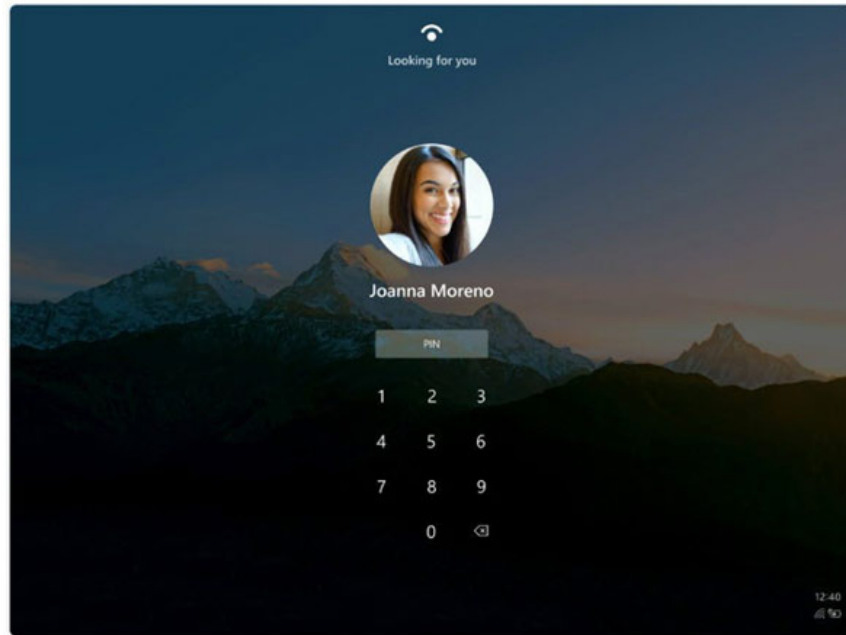

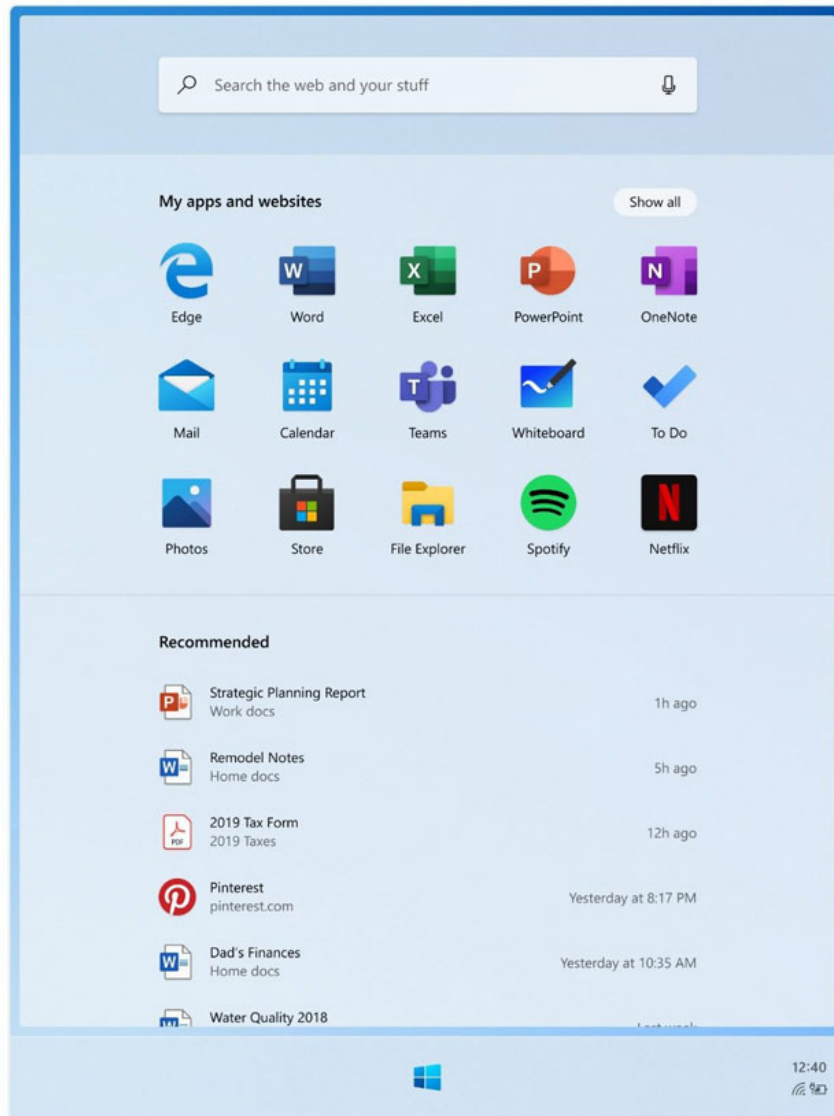
Capability meets simplicity
