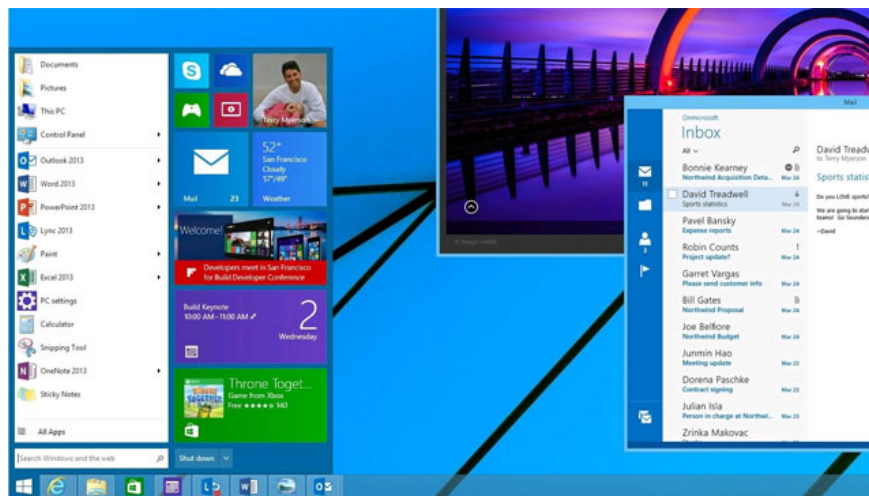


Windows 9 development plan may be changed

Recently, the Chinese government has announced that it prohibits public computers running **Windows 8** and **Windows 8.1** due to concerns about integrating the Modern UI on this operating system version. Although this issue may not seem serious, however, because China is a crowded and important market for Microsoft, the company is rethinking Windows 9 development plans to avoid similar sanctions. Some information about this change has also begun to spread to Microsoft. Microsoft has made a number of significant changes in the testing of internally tested Windows versions. Instead of allowing these unfinished versions to be accessed freely through the Microsoft CorpNet network, employees must now submit a request to download a new trial version and only own it when possible. Microsoft approved.

Information about which versions downloaded by employees will also be stored in Microsoft servers for easy investigation if there is a leak. This change also applies to Microsoft branches in Russia and China. Even more, the restrictions are stricter for Microsoft Chinese employees and some employees in Russia. These employees are not even authorized to request a new test version to avoid leaks in the development process, as before, most leaks originated in China.

These containment efforts are directed towards the Chinese government's ban. Microsoft is working to make major changes to this new version of its operating system and does not want information about these changes to leak out of control. Because the plan has been changed, the source also said that the deadline for launching Windows 9 is likely to be repelled, along with changes in different versions on Windows 9, especially the Enterprise version. .

According to *WZor* , a leaker specializing in leaking test versions of Microsoft, Windows 9 Enterprise will likely not be a cloud operating system like Chrome OS, along with Microsoft will allow users to Completely turn off the Modern UI 2.0 interface.

The changes in the plan have made information about Windows 9 development process more blind than ever. Hopefully, Microsoft will soon announce to its users its plans and plans for this future operating system version.
