

Windows Phone 8 supports Vietnamese typing

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No Vietnamese keyboard is a big limitation of Windows Phone for users in Vietnam, although this platform possesses many unique, interesting and powerful features similar to iOS and Android.

However, it is likely that this restriction will be phased out gradually since the new version when recently a member of the Delicate forum found in the Windows Phone 8 SDK programming tool set to display the Vietnamese language completely. of Windows Phone 8 operating system, released next fall.



Windows Phone 8 will support Vietnamese.

Besides the display language package, Vietnamese keyboards have appeared and allow users to edit the spelling correctly. However, the Microsoft input method currently does not use the familiar input method Telex and Vni but instead is a separate input method. Above the virtual keyboard QWERTY appears a line containing special vowels such as "in the box" and the diacritics, with the "d" consonant .

In addition to Vietnamese language and percussion, the Windows Phone 8 SDK tool also shows that the screen capture feature is built into Microsoft operating system and users can press Home + Camera to enable this feature.

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
