Microsoft has revealed that Windows Phone Store has exceeded 300,000 applications, with "hundreds" of applications being added daily.

In December 2013, the store's number of available apps was 200,000, while in April this year it had about 250,000 - so the Windows Phone store seemed to reach about 50,000 new applications each. four months, or more than 10,000 applications per month.

Besides, Microsoft also said that more than 4 billion applications and games have been downloaded through Windows Phone Store. And these are extremely impressive numbers.
