PhoneArena, on December 4, reiterated *WPCentral*, saying that when users used 3G / 4G networks to access Microsoft's Windows Phone Store online, only applications with capacities of less than 50 MB could be downloaded. . If you exceed this number, you must use a Wi-Fi network.

Currently, the capacity to download 3G / 4G apps on Windows Phone Store has increased to 100 MB.

It is not clear when this new policy will be adopted by Microsoft worldwide.

It is known that in September, Apple also applied policies for users to download online applications at the App Store online store with 3G / 4G with a limit of 100 MB.
