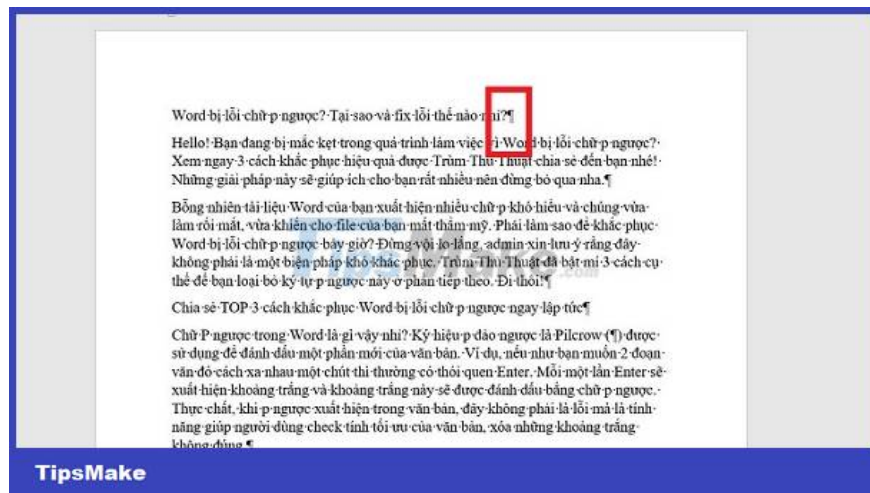


# Word has an error with the letter p backwards? Why and how to fix the error?

## Share TOP 3 ways to fix Word error with backwards letter p immediately

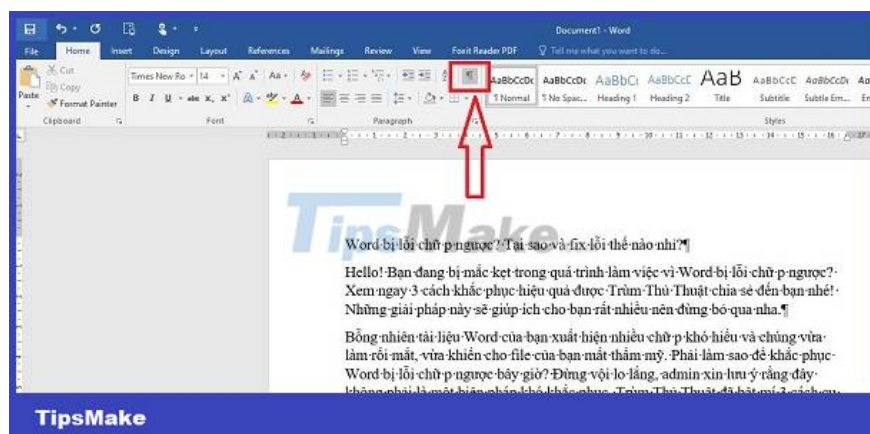
What is the inverted P in Word? The reverse p symbol Pilcrow (¶) is used to mark a new section of text. For example, if you want two paragraphs to be a bit apart, you often have the Enter habit. Each time Enter, a space will appear and this space will be marked with an inverted p. In fact, when inverted p appears in the text, this is not an error but a feature that helps users check the optimization of the text and delete incorrect spaces.

**Note:** This inverted p feature is usually hidden, so it is possible that you have enabled this feature so the letter p appears. The following are ways to delete the letter p backwards in Word.

### 1/ Hide symbols using the toolbar in Word

This is the simplest way to delete the character ¶ inverted p in Word 2016 or other versions so you can hide these 'eye-catching' inverted p letters in one note.

1. **BI** : In the Word document with the letter p upside down> Click the **Home** tab on the toolbar.
2. **Step 2** : Find the '¶' icon and click on it to immediately turn off the inverted p letters on the document.

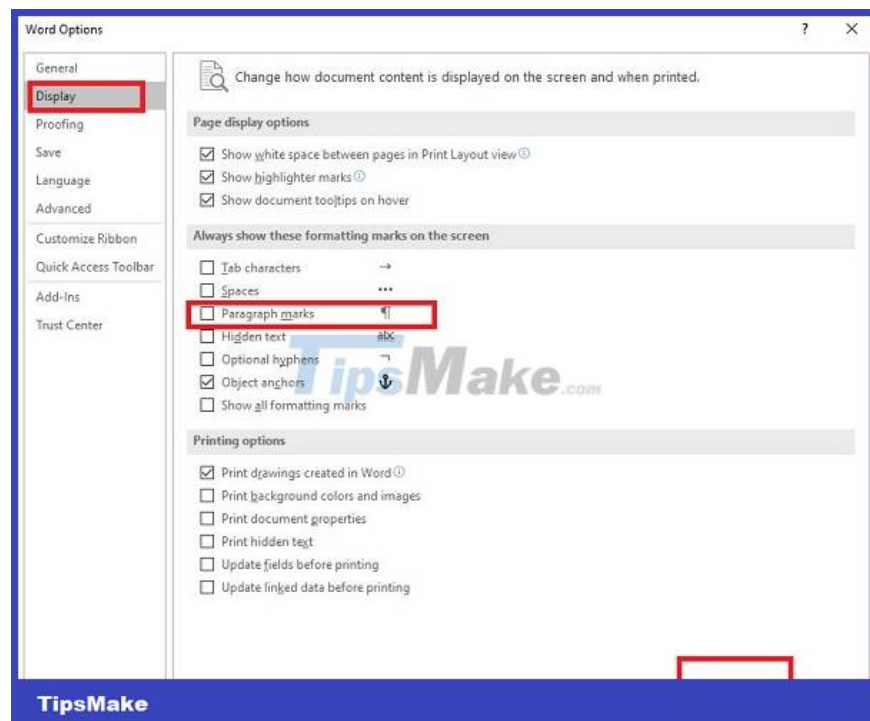


Besides, there is also an even faster way to turn off the inverted p in word: Press the key combination **Ctrl + Shift + 8** to finish. If you want to turn the letter p upside down to check spaces, press this key combination again and you're done.

## 2/ How to delete the inverted p in Word 2

In case you do not need to see this paragraph mark symbol but still want the remaining parts to be unaffected. If you do it the above way, it will hide everything, but this second way will only delete the letter p and the other parts will be kept when you turn on this feature to check.

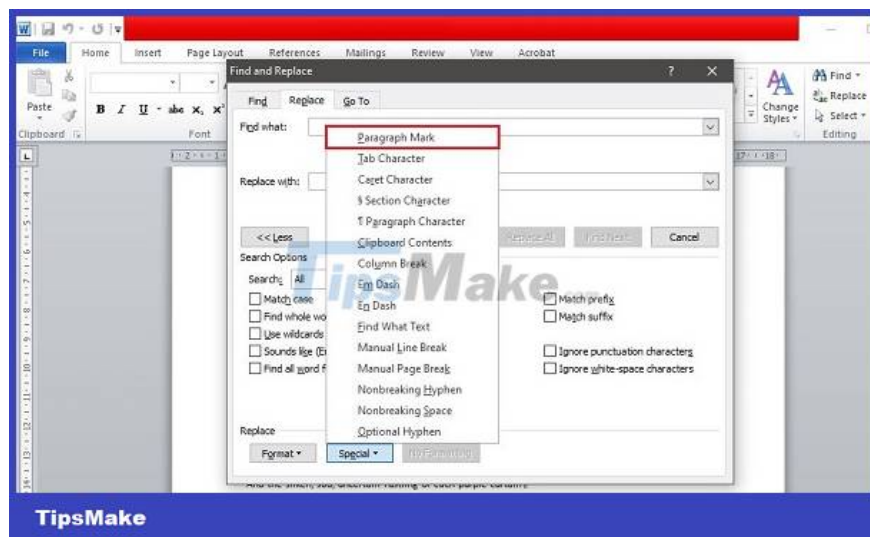
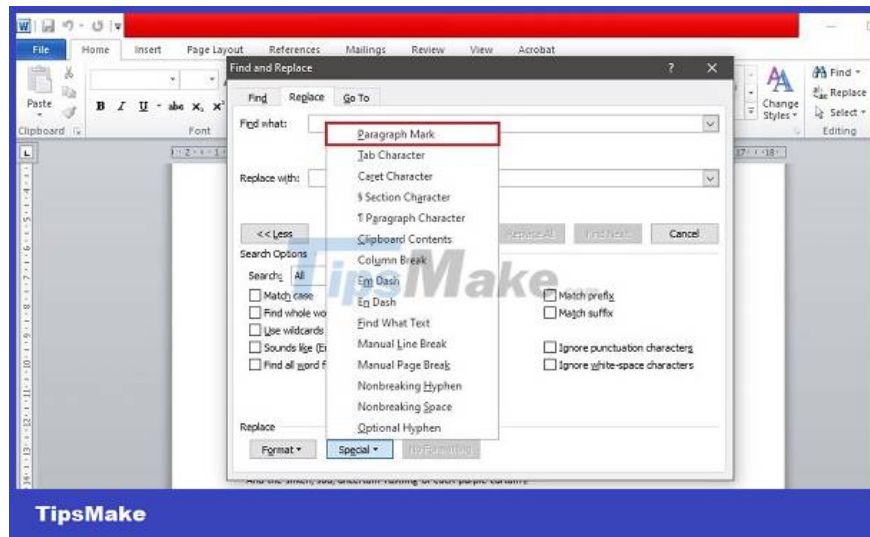
Specifically, in the Word document with the letter p > Click on the **File** tab > Then select **Options** > Continue clicking **Display** in the new window that appears > Find the section ' **Always show these formatting marks on the screen** ' > Uncheck tick ' **Paragraph marks** ' and click **OK** to save.



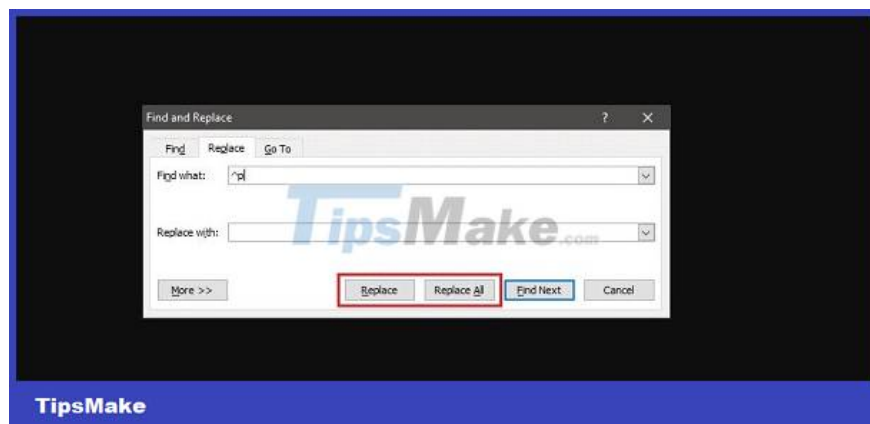
## 3/ Replace Paragraph Marks

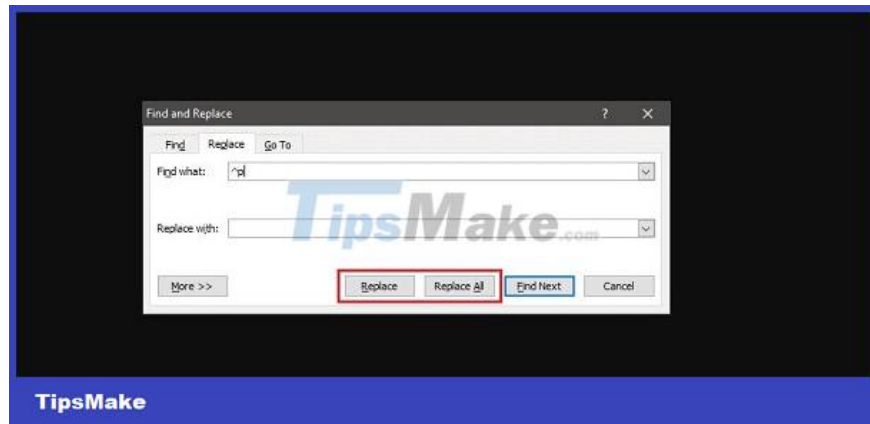
If the user only wants to delete the inverted p symbol in a part of the text, not the entire Word document. Then you need to replace these symbols with a space and delete them. Specifically:

1. **Step 1** : Select the text you need to delete this symbol > Press the key combination **Ctrl + H**.
2. **Step 2** : When the dialog box displays, in the **Find what** section , click to make the cursor appear here > Then click **More >>** in the left corner.
3. **B3** : Continue to click **Special** in the new window displayed> When the list appears, click on **Paragraph Mark** > Now the character p 1 will appear in the Find What section.



1. **B4** : In the **Replace with** section , leave it blank and then click **Replace All** to replace everything or **Replace** to replace a selected part.
