

Xenxo S-Ring: The smartest ring in the world, expensive but capable of everything

If you need an 'outstanding' smart accessory but hate big smartwatches, the Xenxo S-Ring might be the better option.

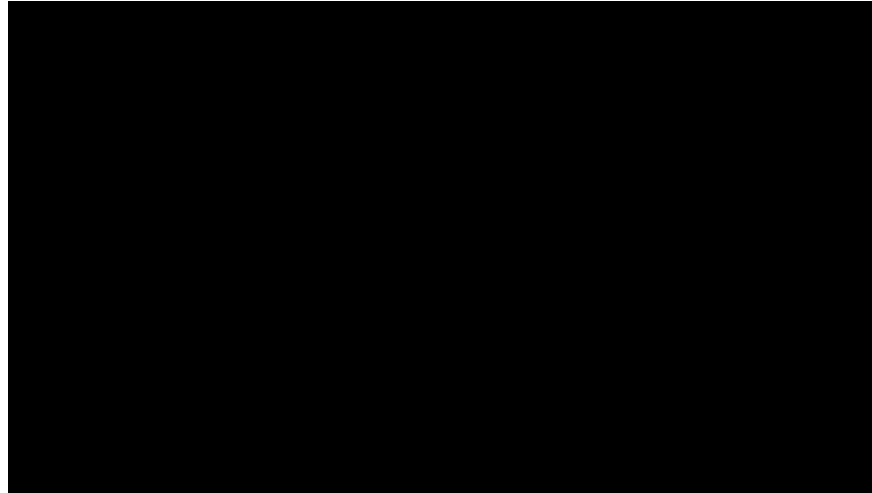
We have seen a lot of smart accessories coming out in recent years. Most of them are watches or bracelets with quite large size. Headphones with intelligent virtual assistants also started to develop strongly not long ago. This type of accessory has met the compact but not convenient to use 24/24 and does not have many really excellent features.

Therefore, many manufacturers have tried to create smart rings. This item is both compact and can be worn anytime and anywhere; and in the case of Xenxo S-Ring it is extremely versatile.



According to Xenxo, the S-Ring is a combination of 6 devices: phones, watches, smart bracelets, keys, wallets and Bluetooth headsets. The superiority of Zenxo S-Ring helps this manufacturer reach a capital of more than \$ 300,000, 12 times higher than the original goal on Kickstarter.

Currently, the Xenxo smart ring project has only 12 days left to raise money and the cheapest packages are about to run out. This is sufficient proof of the attractiveness of the device. It is expected that customers will receive rings by the end of this year.

So, what does Xenxo S-Ring have for people to be willing to pay up to 4 million for a ring?

The first thing to know is the design of the S-Ring. It does not look much different from other types of jewelry rings for young people with quite large horizontal. S-Ring has a surface made of metal and only has an internal touch button for users to manipulate. This device is charged via an exclusive battery cord, not micro-USB or USB-C, and is not damaged even when receiving power from a smartphone charger.



Carry less, Do more!

Inside the S-Ring is what makes people like it so much. From the curved battery, the sensors support motion to the ability to vibrate to transmit sound through the finger bones for voice calls and NFC technology for electronic payments.

Besides, the S-Ring also has 4GB of internal memory, the latest Bluetooth 5.0 LE connectivity, vibration for notifications, health monitoring and many other features that are only found on larger smart devices.
