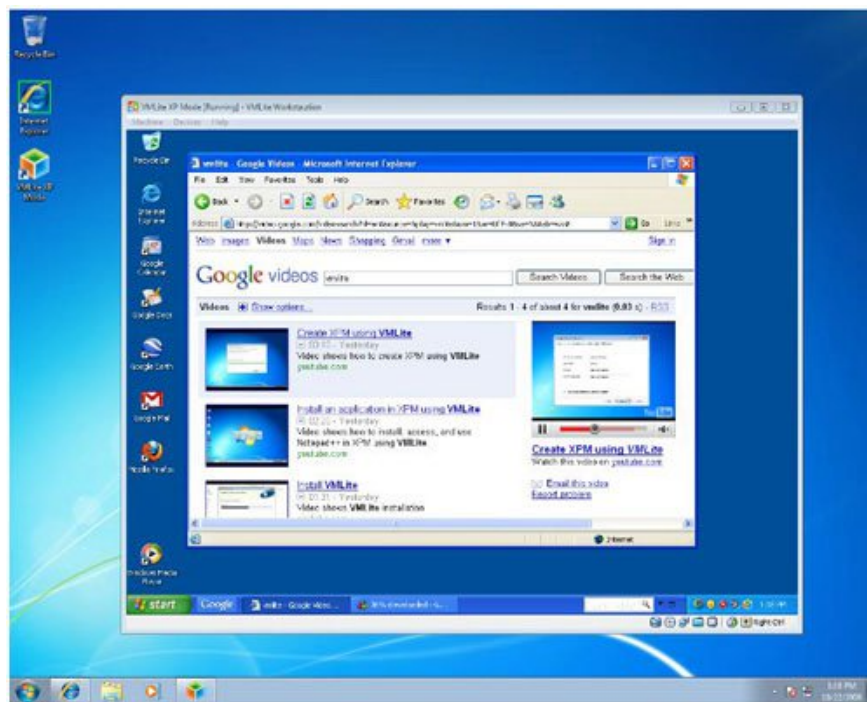


# 'XP mode' in Windows 7 can be compromised by security

According to *Neowin* on January 15, on 8.4.2014, Microsoft will stop all activities supporting the operating system over 10 years old, namely **Windows XP** . And then, the question is whether the " *XP mode* " feature in **Windows 7** is still safe to use.

*ZDNet* cited Microsoft's statement that after April 8.4, Microsoft will not plan to release security patches for the " *XP mode* " feature in Windows 7.

This means that after April 8.4, Windows 7 users who continue to use the " *XP mode* " feature may face security risks.
