1. Question 1. What is "Spam" in email?
 1. Email spam or unwanted advertising email
 2. Special email
 3. Secret email sent to me personally
2. Question 2. Why do Internet sites and services know my email address and I often receive promotional emails or spam?
 1. Do you are famous
 2. Since you have actively or unknowingly provided an email address on the Internet
 3. Do your email provider sell your address
3. Question 3. What is "Phishing" scam in email?
 1. Advertising form via email
 2. Fishing guide form via email
 3. Form of stealing information via email
4. Question 4. I received an email with an attachment, but the content is not clear. What should I do?
 1. Download and open the attachment to see what the content is
 2. Do not download the attachment and delete the email
 3. If the email sent by the celebrity, for example Bui Tien Dung, you can safely open the attachment immediately
5. Question 5. I received emails with very interesting titles like 'Hey, see my nude video', 'Look, my sexy girl friend' . How should I do?
 1. Open the preview
 2. Delete the email and forget it, you won't get anything but the virus
 3. You should forward to others and ask the person to open it first to see if there is a problem
6. Question 6. I received an email from the address with the display name as Facebook, asked to verify my account / password, with an authentic link (like the image below). Should I click?
 1. This is information from Facebook, you can trust and follow the instructions
 2. Email may not be from Facebook, you need to check the real link before clicking on it
 3. Websites often have authentication steps when registering an account, so this is a secure email
7. Question 8. I received an email from a foreigner, thanks to receiving and transferring large amounts of money, then receiving a 30% remuneration. I also received another email asking to act as an intermediary agent for foreign companies to buy goods, they pledged to pay 60% commission . Gmail has warned spam with these emails, what should I do?
 1. You are lucky to receive such suggestions, follow what they instruct.
 2. You should not believe this and delete the email
 3. Gmail can be confused when marking as spam, because this email is only sent to you and not sent to others
8. Question 7. What should I do when I receive an email with the content: 'You received this email because you are one of 10 people who bring me luck. Forward this email to 10 other lucky people. If you do not

forward this email, you will take the risk of everyone . '

1. Please send this email immediately, because this is a charm
 2. You need to delete the email immediately from the mailbox
 3. You do not need to do anything, this is just a joke by email
9. Question 9. How to use email to send sensitive information like bank account, password, credit card information?
1. Email should not be used to send sensitive information directly. If absolutely necessary, enter the information into a file and set the password for the file and attach it via email
 2. Take a picture and send the information according to the attached file
 3. Send this information normally via email
10. Question 10. A website asking me to become a member, must authenticate by emailing a picture of the credit card, how should I do it?
1. Verify the information given by the website, if it is possible, take a picture of the front of the credit card, delete part of the card information and email the website
 2. You do not send any information to such sites
 3. You can send any credit card images I find on the Internet
