Cannot use analog in Menu



The first Easter egg of the game appears right from the menu. Not only does the original game menu background recreate more beautifully and impressively, but the remake's menu is close to the original in an unbelievable way. Back in 1997, the PS1 controller had no analog stick at this time, the direction control had to be based on the d-pad, and of course the menu control was no exception. Up to the remake, the game is so loyal to the original that the menu can only be controlled by the d-pad, not analog like other games. This may be a bit confusing for people who are familiar with analog when first entering the game.

How to have hairstyles like Cloud



One of Cloud's most recognizable 'markers' is his extreme hairstyle. So have you ever wondered how Cloud can maintain such a strong head even in combat? Does Cloud have to use a brand of quality hair care shampoo? As expected the game also partly explains that. In the game, players can come across Hair Tonic billboards, a certain hair care product. The problem is probably what Cloud used this type, so for added certainty, the product also adds a description of 'for shiny and pointed hair'. Photos from the original



Tifa's bar 7th Heaven is one of the most memorable places in the original FFVII. Up to the Remake version, due to the change in graphics technology and game design, this bar must also be redesigned accordingly. However, the developers still make the bar loyal and as close to the original as possible. In this bar there are a lot of pictures that look quite blurry and hard to see, most gamers probably will not pay much attention to them. However, if you pay close attention to you will realize that it is all the image of the original bar, it shows how much Final Fantasy VII has changed but still retains the essence of the original.

White apple juice



In the billboards appearing in the game, players can encounter signs with the content of white apple juice with the words 'Delicious! Fresh! Good for health!'. If you've ever played Crisis Core: Final Fantasy VII on your PSP, you might remember the fruit that only grew in Banora village. This is not the first time that the white apple mentioned when Final Fantasy XV not long ago had easter eggs about this fruit.

Link to Final Fantasy X-2



This can be considered as the smartest and most interesting easter egg of the game. Accordingly, at the end of the game at Shinra headquarters, players can see a large image of many Shinra employees. Among the people in

the picture there is one character that stands out from all. Specifically, in the middle of the photo is an adult version of the genius boy Al Bhed in Final Fantasy X-2. Fans have historically made several assumptions about the connection between Final Fantasy VII and Final Fantasy X-2, arguing that they are in the same world and have a content connection. So this may be the clearest evidence so far.

From the beginning of the year until now, we have heard again and again about the situation of the Covid-19 pandemic taking place worldwide, which has led to the upheaval of daily life of the people.
